

B Y L A W 5/83

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF EARL GREY TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES.

The Council of the Village of Earl Grey in the province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Under the provisions of Section 21 of the Snowmobile Act of 1978, it shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. on any public highway except Provincial Highway No. 22 within the limits of the said Village.
2. Notwithstanding Section 1 of this bylaw it shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile on the portion of Provincial Highway No. 22 for the purpose of crossing said highway.
3. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final approval of the Highway Traffic Board.
4. Bylaw 2/83 is hereby repealed.
