

Bylaw 6-2004


A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT KEEPING OF LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY  
WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF VILLAGE OF EARL GREY

The Council of the Village of Earl Grey, in the Province of  
Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression "municipality" means  
the Village of Earl Grey.
2. No person shall keep any livestock or poultry at any time within  
the corporate limits of the Village of Earl Grey in the area lying  
to the south of Railway Avenue and to the north of Saskatchewan  
Avenue.
4. A person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw shall be  
liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the  
municipality.
5. Bylaw 6/90 is hereby repealed.
