Sutter/Mohr: That Council, due to the failure of the purchaser, Kurtis & Nicole Becker, to fulfill their obligations under the duly signed "Offer to Purchase" agreement dated Oct. 22, 2021 in reference to these specific sections:

- Section 3.3 of the "Offer to Purchase" Council has not received a Building Permit within 12 months
 of the acceptance of the Offer to Purchase for the development of Lot 11 Block 9, Plan #77R31053
 from Kurtis & Nicole Becker;
- 2. Section 3.4 of the "Offer to Purchase" Kurtis & Nicole Becker have not completed the said improvements with 24 months of the signing of the "Offer to Purchase" (Oct. 22, 2021);

THEREFORE, Council is granted permission to terminate this agreement under Section 5.1(b) and 5.1(c) and call upon the Purchaser, Kurtis & Nicole Becker, for the transfer of the Property, Lot 11 Block 9 Plan #77R31053 back to the Village.

FURTHERMORE, Under Section 5.4 (b) (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) where the title to the property has been transferred to the purchaser:

- 1. The Village can call upon and realize upon any bond provided by the Purchaser;
- 2. Terminate this agreement and call upon the Purchaser for a transfer back of the Property to the Village (with which demand the Purchaser shall be obliged to comply forthwith);
- Take all steps as may be reasonably necessary to restore the property to a reasonably saleable condition and charge the costs to the Purchaser, who shall forthwith pay such costs directly to the Village; and
- 4. Bring legal proceedings against the Purchaser to recover title to the Property and/or costs charged to the Purchaser pursuant to subparagraph (iii) above.

FURTHERMORE, In the event that the Purchaser shall be in default of its obligations under paragraph 5.1 (c) of this Agreement, the Village may, in its sole discretion have recourse to any and all remedies set out in paragraph 5.4 (b).

IN CONCLUSION, Council will start legal proceedings for the transfer of Lot 11 Block 9 Title #77R31053 from Kurtis & Nicole Becker into the name of the Village of Earl Grey and any and all costs will be Kurtis & Nicole Becker's.
