



gessner and fondren has access - entryway to missouri city

Texas Pkwy/Cartwright/Fm 1092 - Main thoroughfares and high traffic areas that bring people in and out of the areas. Texas Parkway, Cartwright and 1092: All high traffic areas but wish they would be redeveloped.

trammel fresno - gateway from pearland, has potential to look nicer

Fondren Rd - opportunities for shared spaces - shared offices; food parks; visibility Gessner - Likes the industry with jobs, its near the Beltway, clean streets.

Cartwright Rd - Community Rec Center. It has a lot of activities for the product being sold. Trammel Fresno - few ways to be connected to Pearland, needs expansion. Currently too congested but has potential.

Texas Parkway, Cartwright and 1092: Aging infrastructure and buildings

1092 - lack of sit down restaurants

Gessner & Fondren - safety concerns, needs to be more presentable like other areas of the city, homeless population in area, SOBs, needs to streamline into something better Multiple modes of transportation - what happens when you don't have a car.

Knights Rd. - Dead animals on the road, no lights, and lack of development.

Cartwright - lack of grocery stores
