#### **DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Dogs with physical challenges Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge. (Chapter 2, Section 3 of the Scent Work Regulations).

No entries will be accepted by phone, fax, or electronic means except as detailed below. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. ALL checks received will be deposited and must clear to be considered a valid entry.

**Returned Checks/Declined Transactions** Trial Secretary will add a \$25 service charge for any returned check or declined credit card transaction. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in being placed on a CASH ONLY basis.

**Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks and declined credit card transactions do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of such entries. **ALL checks received will be deposited and must clear to be considered a valid entry.** 

#### **REFUNDS**

**No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. **Dogs pulled after closing** because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

**Bitches in season** will be refunded the full entry fee less a \$5 per trial processing fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of each trial. Refunds will be mailed after completion of the trial.



A note about fees from the Pacific NW Scent Work Club The first trials in the Pacific NW were more than seven years ago. We know so much more about the effort and space required for a quality all breed and all element scent work trial than back then, but the fees have stayed the same. So yes, it's going to cost a bit more for our events. But because we do cost more, we are able to offer a more convenient and comfortable staging area for everyone and well qualified friendly judges. Thank you for your continued support of our events.

#### **CLASSIFICATIONS**

Novice A Classes are open to dogs who have not completed any title for that particular element, who have not completed a comparable title with another organization, and whose handlers are neither Scent Work judges, nor have ever worked as professional detection dog handlers.

Novice B Classes are open to all dogs.

Advanced Classes are open to dogs who have achieved the Novice title for that particular element.

Excellent Classes are open to dogs who have achieved the Advanced title for that particular element.

Master Classes are open to dogs that have achieved the Excellent title for that particular element.

Detective class is open to dogs who have achieved a Master title in any Odor Element.

Handler Discrimination classes are titling classes in which the targeted scent is that of the handlers themselves. Handlers are required to provide their own scented articles in a plastic bag. For the Novice class, one cotton glove or cotton sock, for Advanced, Excellent, and Master, cotton balls or cotton swabs. Three qualifying scores are required to earn titles in each class. Handlers may utilize any method to scent their article except by applying oils used for Odor elements. Suggestions include rubbing the article on the handler's body or storing the item in dirty laundry.

Dogs may enter up to two (2) difficulty levels in each element, in each trial. Dogs may only enter a class once in each event. A class is defined as a particular difficulty level within a particular element, For example, a dog may run in both Novice B and Advanced Interior in the same event, but may not run in Novice Interior twice in the same event. Dogs may only enter classes for which they are eligible according to the above guidelines. Dogs that have previously earned the same or higher level AKC Scent Work titles may also enter lower level classes.

## **RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES**

All prizes and ribbons must be claimed day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

First Place.....Blue Second Place......Red Third Place......Yellow Fourth Place.....White Qualifying Score......Dark Green A special qualifying ribbon will be awarded each team qualifying in Detective

A **New Element Title rosette** will be awarded to teams finishing an Element title.

A **New Level Title rosette** will be awarded to teams finishing a Level title. *Note there are different rosettes for* 

completing an HD level title as well as a Master or Excellent level title.

High in Trial (HIT) Teams earning High in Trial in each level will receive a HIT rosette. (Offered at all events)Only teams who participate in all elements in the same difficulty level offered (Container, Interior, Exterior, and Buried), and qualify in each element, are eligible to win High in Trial. One HIT winner is chosen for each level; there is not a separate HIT for the Novice A and Novice B sections. The HIT is determined by adding each team's faults across the elements.

High Combined Division Trial (HCD) Teams earning High Combined Division in each level will receive a HCD rosette. Teams who participate in all elements including Handler Discrimination in the same difficulty level offered (Container, Interior, Exterior, Buried, and Handler Discrimination), and qualify in each element, are eligible to win the HCD award. One HCD winner is chosen for each level; there is not a separate HCD for the Novice A and Novice B sections. The HCD is determined by adding each team's faults across the elements.

Ties If there is a tie based on faults for any award, then each team's times across the elements will be summed and the faster-finishing team wins.

#### **SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS**

**Search Area Conditions.** Searches may be indoors, on matted, carpeted, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces. This facility is ADA accessible throughout.

**Search Area Sizes** Refer to the Scentwork Regulations for search area sizes and other requirements. Search areas may be of any shape and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class.

**Exhibitors MUST check-in for each trial in which they are entered.** Time listed are approximate and may change after entries close or on the day of trial. Check schedule included with your entry confirmation to be sure.

#### STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

**Staging Area** will be in the climate controlled Columbia Hall including check-in, warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for posting of running order, results, and ribbons. Public restrooms will also be in this area. **Crating space** will be available on first come first claimed basis; gear may be left inside overnight. Please be considerate of other exhibitors and make economical use of the available space. *Reactive or noisy dogs may be asked to stage from their vehicles*.

**Dog exercise Area** – will be designated grass areas east of Columbia Hall. Dogs must remain on leash at all times and handlers must practice social distance of at least 6 feet between humans. No parking except in the asphalt lot east of Columbia Hall without permission of event chair. **Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s).** Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

**Handlers Briefing** will be conducted onsite by the judge as you enter the search area. There will be a group briefing prior to the start of each day's judging and will include a walkthrough of the area.

**Warm-up Area** One labelled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less so that others may be able to use the warm-up area as well. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog. (Chapter 5, Section 34 of the Scent Work Regulations).

**Trial Site.** It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future. (Chapter 3, Section 15 of the Scent Work Regulations).

**Possession of Odors and Training**. Chapter 5, Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".



Event Results Preliminary results are posted as soon as we enter results. You may pick up your ribbons based on preliminary results when available. We enter results from the actual judges score sheets and Phyllis rarely makes an error. BUT, they are preliminary results and may change after the judge reviews each and every one of them. Often that doesn't happen until after everyone is gone for the day. If you think there is an error, please let the information desk know and we'll follow up on it with the judge when we can. If no one is there, just grab a transfer form and leave us a note that includes your name, dog name, element and class, and armband number. But please, DO NOT HARASS OR DISTURB THE SECRETARY. Each interruption means time away from getting your

results entered and ready for judge review.

#### **VOLUNTEERS**

A successful trial depends on the help of its volunteers. Please let us know if you would like to help in any of the following areas.

#### **Job Descriptions**

Note: many volunteer positions require walking, standing and bending. \*May be sit down jobs.

Chief Steward – organizes, trains, deploys volunteers throughout event. May also work the gate or score table.

**Element Set up** – Ensures all setup is complete for assigned Element, at the Judges direction, including line of site, start lines, boundary marking. *Friday afternoon, Saturday afternoon, Sunday afternoon* 

**Clean up** – Site preparation for the next day, removal and loading of all trial gear at Trial(s) completion.

- \*Timer Timing competitor runs. Timer may not time a class in which he or she is exhibiting.
- \*Gate Steward Managing flow for the trial element area, assisting competitors positioning pre-search.
- \*Judges Steward Bring competitors to the start line, remind them of the time limit and leash options for the search. Cleanup between competitors may be required, including sweeping, vacuuming, or returning spilled sand to the container, and mopping slopped water.

HD Hide Steward (includes Hot Box Steward) must wear latex or nitrile gloves when handling odor containers/boxes, etc. to prevent contamination Handles and places hides for handler scented item at the Judge's direction.

Score Runner - carries score sheets from search areas to Score Table throughout the trial.

\*Registration – Check in of arriving Competitors and Volunteers. Assistance at Score Table with verification of score sheet completion before data entry.
