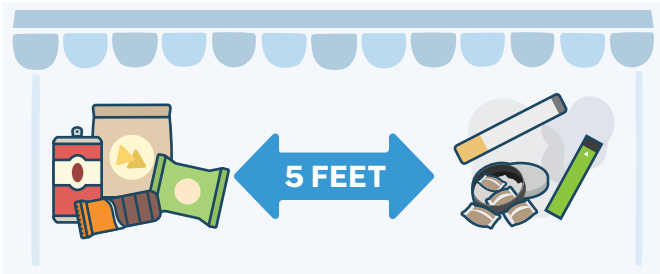

Tips for Compliance

Crescent City's Tobacco Retail License Ordinance, effective November 15, 2023.

This law sets rules on how stores advertise tobacco products.

In Stores



In order to keep tobacco products and ads away from products young people might buy:*

- Tobacco products must be over **5 feet away** from candy, snacks, or non-alcoholic beverages.
- Any tobacco ads or promotions must be over **5 feet away** from candy, snacks, or non-alcoholic beverages.

**This rule does not apply to stores that require customers to be over age 21.*

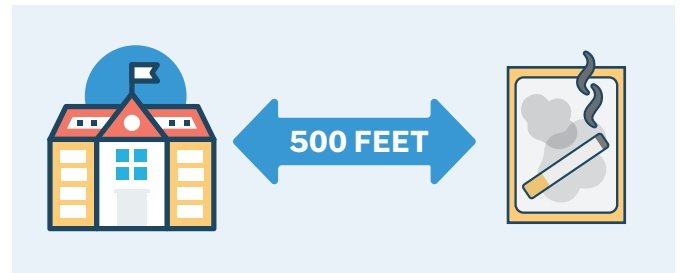

In Communities



All tobacco ads or promotions must be at least **500 feet away** from:

- Schools – including elementary, secondary, and high schools
- Public playgrounds and playground areas in parks
- Daycare centers
- Community centers
- Public libraries

Note: Stores with a pharmacy are not allowed to sell tobacco products.
