This year has been marked by significant growth in our programming, successful fundraising initiatives, and a profound commitment to uplifting our community through health, education, and essential support services. W Empowering Our Community: Program Highlights

Our core programs saw impactful success in 2025, directly benefiting individuals and families facing various challenges The highlight of our year was the successful execution of our Wellness Expo sponsored by AdamH in August. This comprehensive event served as a hub of support and resources for the local community:

- * Back-to-School Support: We proudly sponsored 30 back-to-school haircuts, ensuring students started the year with confidence.
- * Essential Supplies: We provided school supplies to 50 families, alleviating financial burdens as the academic year began.
- * Legal Aid: We hosted a crucial criminal record expungement clinic, offering a path to a fresh start for community members.
- *Shared healing practices of Yoga, Reiki and Self-Defense to the community. With the

Our targeted programs continued to provide tangible relief and essential resources:

- * Wigs for Brains: This program, dedicated to restoring confidence for those experiencing hair loss due to medical conditions, successfully donated 2 high-quality wigs this year.
- * Adapting Abilities: Focused on providing essential medical and accessibility equipment, we donated:
 - * 2 baby carriers
 - * 1 cane
 - * 2 elevated bathtub
- * Hospital and Financial Assistance: Recognizing the immediate needs of those undergoing medical crises:
 - * We sent 4 comprehensive hospital boxes filled with comfort and necessity items.
 - * We provided \$700 in financial assistance to families facing emergent medical-related costs.
- *Worked virtually & in person with 10 families as a patient advocate

Educational Empowerment

Through the Those Who Endure Annual Scholarship, we invested in the future by awarding 2 scholarships to deserving students who are brain surgery survivors and have demonstrated resilience and academic promise. This is the first year in our 7 year history that we've awarded more than one scholarship at a time.

We are thrilled to announce the successful launch of our new program, The Endure More Support Line. This initiative provides a confidential resource for emotional and practical support. connecting individuals enduring chronic illness or recovery with resources and a listening ear. This marks a major step in expanding our reach beyond physical aid to encompass crucial mental and emotional wellness.

Financials and Fundraising Success

Our fundraising efforts in 2025 exceeded expectations, demonstrating strong community belief in our mission.

Through our events and partnerships, we successfully raised over \$4,000 this year. Key fundraising successes included:

- * Partnership with Jeni's Splendid Ice Creams: A popular and delicious way to raise funds while engaging the community.
