

Walk 'n Roll Wednesdays Start

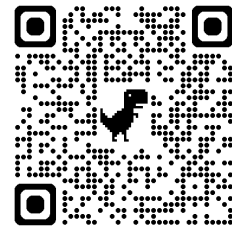

We are excited to be rolling into the 2nd year of our Walk N Roll program at Gregory Gardens! Walk N Roll is creating a culture of active transportation and climate awareness at our school. Using an app called Active4me, volunteers greet and check in participating students' key tags when they arrive on bikes, scooters, by walking, or by carpool. Active4me records students' trips, miles traveled, and CO2 saved using barcode scanning technology. The program is fun and inspiring, and also sends an optional notification to parents that your child checked in at school. Gregory Gardens is proud to be an active campus where we all work together as a team: those who can get to school in an active way or by carpool do so, making way for those who need to drive; those who need to drive do so carefully, making it safe for active transporters. Let's all travel together for a sustainable future.

Registration is easy

- Pick up a key tag for your student at All in One Day or Walk N Roll Wednesdays at the Walk N Roll Station. Attach it to a zipper on your child's backpack.
- If you have a key tag from last year, then keep using it. It stays with your child until they graduate from our school
- Individualize your distance and mode of transportation, as well as receive a notification that your student arrived at school, **and register with the QR code here**. Registration is not required for participation, but it is fun and encourages kids through their own statistics. Registration is self-reported distance; no address is needed.
- If walking or rolling to school is not possible for you, carpooling is encouraged and can be registered as well!

Taking this route through quieter neighborhood streets might add a few minutes, but it's a calmer, more enjoyable way to start your day.

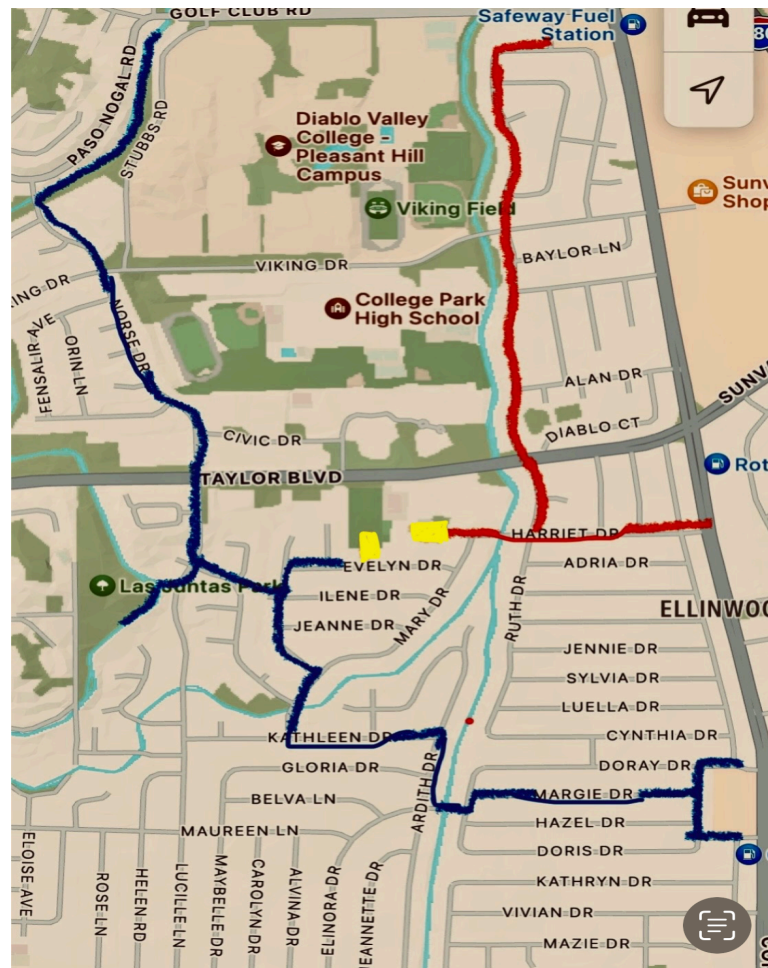
We also want to remind families that getting your student to school safely and on time is your responsibility, and we encourage everyone in our community to use active and eco-friendly transportation whenever possible.
