## RANCH RULES ACCEPTANCE FORM

- 1. All hunters, non-hunting companions must comply with all regulations concerning wearing of hunter orange.
- 2. All game laws must be strictly complied with, including but not limited to tagging of animals, care of meat, hunting from roads or vehicles etc. Hunters and non-hunting companions must familiarize themselves with State, Federal, Ranch and local game laws.
- 3. Access to cooperative wildlife management unit does not include or permit access to adjoining private land or any other land than the Alfalfa fields.
- 4. Absolutely no open fires.
- 5. Care must be taken to avoid damage to ranch roads. During extreme weather some roads will be closed.
- 6. Hunters may access the agriculture fields on two-track roads or perimeter roads only. No driving in the fields to retrieve game.
- 7. Absolutely no shooting any other animals or creatures on the cooperative wildlife management unit.
- 8. All <u>hunters</u> and non-hunting companions are required to sign a "Acceptance of Ranch Rules and Regulations form" before entering or hunting on the Cooperative Wildlife Management Unit.
- 9. Hunters will coordinate hunting times and camping areas with the Cooperative Wildlife Management Unit Operator. (Gary Webb, 801-836-8411).
- 10. All hunters and non-hunting companions will not disturb land owners cattle, horses, sheep or livestock of any kind.
- 11. Absolutely NO chains on vehicles allowed on property.

By signing below, I acknowledge that I have read the above "Ranch Rules Acceptance Form" and will strictly adhere to each rule. I also acknowledge that if do not follow any of these rules, I will forfeit my right to hunt or accompany a hunter on the Junction Valley Cooperative Wildlife Management Unit. The operator, at his discretion reserves the right to forfeit your right to hunt based on his/hers evaluation of how you follow the ranch rules.
