DeSoto County Board of Supervisors

DeSoto County is governed by five elected District Supervisors. Supervisors are elected to four-year terms by citizens in their district. While each Supervisor represents his or her district, all the members are expected to look after the good of DeSoto County as a whole.

DeSoto County Supervisors have full authority over roads and bridges in unincorporated DeSoto County, county law enforcement, collections, levying taxes, and fines. The Board is responsible for establishing policy for the complex multi-million-dollar budgets of county government. The Board also adopts rules, ordinances, and regulations as necessary for the general welfare of the County and its citizens.

DeSoto County Board of Supervisors

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DISTRICT 1: Supervisor Jessie Medlin First Elected: 1991

District One is in the eastern part of DeSoto County. It includes part of Olive Branch, Fairhaven, and Ingrams Mill.



DISTRICT 2: Supervisor Mark Gardner First Elected: 2011

District Two contains most of the City of Southaven and the western part of the City of Olive Branch.



DISTRICT 3: Supervisor Ray Denison First Elected: 2019

District Three is in western DeSoto County. It includes Walls, Lake Commorant, part of Southaven, and Horn Lake.



DISTRICT 4: Supervisor Lee Caldwell First Elected: 2011

District Four contains the Eudora community, and part of Nesbit, Hernando, Horn Lake, and Southaven.

Homestead Exemption-Additional Benefit Applications accepted January 1—April

Residents 65 years or older, and persons who are totally disabled, who are otherwise eligible for a homestead exemption, are exempt from taxes on the first \$75,000 of true value on their home. Must be 65 or older on or before January 1 of that tax year to qualify. Only apply once—unless circumstances change. Prescription Discount Card

Seniors 65 and older may request an absentee ballot 45 days prior to election. County residents who are permanently disabled are eligible for a permanent absentee ballot. To request an absentee ballot, an affidavit must be signed.

Mississippi SNAP provides monthly benefits that help low income households buy food. Special Rules for people 60 or older:

- Medical expenses more than \$35 a month, paid by the senior, are deducted from qualifying income.
- Households consisting entirely of elderly or disabled members are not subject to work requirements.

Senior Scams & Fraud Prevention

No matter your age, no one is immune to scams. Romance Scams are riskiest for ages 5521 through 64. Travel/Vacation Timeshare scams are riskiest for ages 65+. BBB recommends the following precautions to avoid becoming a victim.

Know the Red Flags. Most scammers use common. Keep an eye out for the following too-good-to-be-true claims:

- "Free," "low cost," or "buy one, get one" deal
- Request for unusual payment types (prepaid debit cards)
- Claims you only pay postage or administrative fees
- Pressure to act now and/or aggressive tones
- Deals secured with credit cards or bank information
- Sure-fire investment opportunities
- Charities that send 100% of donations directly victims

Phone Fraud: Fake telemarketers claim to be with a utility/bank/government agency. They demand payment. They may even have a caller ID to match their claims. However, caller IDs can be faked. When in doubt, hang up the phone and call the official source to verify unexpected or unusual claims.

Home Repair Scams Con artists knock on doors with fake flyers stating they are doing landscaping, roofing, paving, etc in the area. They demand cash up front and don't do the work.

Grandparent Scam Scammer impersonates grandchild and whispers saying they are in trouble and need money.

Medicare/Medicaid Fraud Fake representative gets personal information to open accounts and apply for credit cards.

Sweepstakes and Lottery Scams To get the "prize" you have to send money for taxes, shipping, or processing fees.

Funeral Scams Scammer reads obituary and reaches out to widow claiming there is money owed for some past business.

Sweetheart Swindles Scammers create compelling backstories and identities online and charms the victim over a period of time. Then they ask for money for an emergency, medical expenses, or other heartbreaking issues.
