#### **Plant Update:**

The auto-start for the generator at the plant is only \$5,700.00. This will allow the generator to be started as soon as the electricity goes out instead of the on-call person racing to the plant in bad weather or the middle of the night.

#### **Old Business:**

<u>Water Line Replacement:</u> Cactus Park Rd is finishing. Milk Creek is close to getting started, T-75 Rd. <u>Reconnect with Cedaredge:</u> The Cedaredge Town Administrator is interested in a reconnection for Emergencies.

Valve Locations: Work is progressing on GPS Valve locations, at least 50% done.

<u>Funding for Distribution</u>: It is time to have the engineer do the PER/PNA for the next part of the

Grant/Loan. This will be separate from the Lead/Copper and HAA5 treatment design.

Education: Jed and Kurt are working on their next treatment license.

<u>Lead & Copper Inventory:</u> We have about 450 taps that were installed before 1990. We will do a survey of the current owners of those taps.

Fire Mitigation: The next meeting will be in October in Grand Junction with the Forest Service.
