## Fishing Rules and Regulations

- 1. Only members and their guests are allowed to fish. Guests must be accompanied by a member at ALL times.
- 2. **Fishing at Shadow Lake (lake and ponds) is <u>Catch-and-Release</u> ONLY.** All fish caught while fishing in the Lakes or in the Pond, must be returned "ALIVE" to the waters. Violations will be addressed by the Board of Trustees. Please report any violations to the Board.
- 3. Fishing and boating is available from dawn until dusk. Early morning lake and boat users are asked to keep noise to a minimum.
- 4. Fishing equipment must not be left unattended and should be placed in a safe manner when not in use
- 5. Only proper bait (live or lure) is permitted. No trolling nets or other unconventional fishing methods are permitted.
- 6. Food is not permitted and all trash (hooks, lines, bait, etc.) must be removed when you leave the premises. Decks and patio must be left in clean condition, in respect for the next user.
- 7. Club functions and events take priority over fishing activities.
- 8. Vandalism, destruction or defacement of Shadow Lake property will cause immediate suspension of fishing privileges and possible further action by the Board of Trustees.
- 9. Disruptive behavior, use of foul language, or horseplay may result in suspension of fishing privileges as determined by the Board of Trustees, at their sole discretion.
- 10. The lake and ponds may NOT be rented for parties. The renting of the Shadow Lake Club House does NOT entitle the member or guest to use the lake.
- 11. Fishing is not permitted in front of the club house during club house rentals, unless permission is granted by the renter.
- 12. Fishing from a private home requires the permission of the homeowner.
