

Shadow Lake Club Boat Rules

1. The lake is open to small boats only: row boats, kayaks, canoes, paddle boats and small sailboats.
2. No gasoline motors are allowed on the lake. Electric trolling motors are allowed.
3. ALL BOAT OWNERS MUST REGISTER THEIR BOATS ANNUALLY WITH SHADOW LAKE CLUB by June 30. Certain areas are designated for boat storage and only those areas are allowed for boat storage on club property. You have the option to store your boat year round from April 1 – March 31 or seasonally.
4. Unregistered boats will be removed from the racks by July 1.
5. Children under the age of 13 must wear Coast Guard approved PFD's (life vests.)
6. In accordance with STATE LAW, each person on board must have a Coast Guard approved life saving device on board when boating.
7. Members may but should not exceed the occupancy rating of the craft they are using.
8. No swimming is allowed from any boat.
9. It is expected that all persons will conduct themselves at all times in a safe manner. Anyone who mis-uses the boats or conducts themselves in such a manner as to endanger themselves or others will be liable to loss of their Club boating privileges.
10. Parents will be held financially responsible for any damages done to any boat by their children.
11. It is recommended that items such as oars, paddles, sails, masts, centerboards and rudders be taken home after each use. The Club is not responsible for any damages to or theft of boats or equipment. We recommend that boats be removed from club property by Sept. 30th. Contact [REDACTED] with any questions.
12. Cars and trailers must be parked in the parking lots.
13. A NJ fishing license is required for all persons over the age of 14. Unlicensed persons and trespassers are subject to citations and fines from the Bureau of Law Enforcement, NJ Dept. of Environmental Protection, Division of Fish, Game and Wildlife.
