- Support the desire of my child to play their chosen sports for enjoyment without forcing them to participate.
- Encourage my child to play by the rules and applaud the good plays of both teams.
- Emphasize skill development and support the importance of practices and the benefits to our young athletes.
- Support the officials on and off the court/playing field. Criticism of the officials is not acceptable.
- Applaud good effort in both victory and defeat.
- Recognize the importance of volunteer coaches and the many program volunteers. They are important to the development of my child and the program.
- Refrain from yelling at players, coaches, officials, spectators or other parents.
- If you have an issue to address with a coach, please observe a cooling off period and wait at least 24 hours before making contact.

I agree that if I fail to follow the **Parent's Code of Conduct** while attending or participating in a youth sports event, I will be subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to the following in any order or combination:

- Verbal warning issued by an official, head coach, or W.A.Y.S.A league representative.
- Written Warning
- Game suspension or immediate ejection from event with written documentation of incident kept on file by organization involved.
- Suspension from multiple events.
- Game forfeit determined by official or coach.
- Season suspension or multiple season suspension issued by a W.A.Y.S.A representative.
