THE NEHEMIAH CHALLENGE

52 DAYS OF PRAYER REBUILDING THE WALL—FAMILY BY FAMILY

We believe Jesus wants to rebuild a wall of righteousness around our broken world—family by family —just like He did in Nehemiah chapter 3. **For the next 52 days (the time it took Nehemiah to rebuild the wall around Jerusalem) we will pray Scripture asking Jesus to come in power and do a new work in our families.** By this we mean our extended families and all generations. Let's pray expecting the Lord to save, forgive, set free, heal, restore, deliver from evil, transform by His Spirit, and lead us. We look forward to hearing the testimonies of what He will do!

As you use this resource each day we encourage you to **read the Scriptures carefully**, maybe write them out, **listen to any specific ways the Spirit is leading you to pray** for your family and **have a journal where you can write them down.**

We also recommend that you read Scripture aloud over your family and always pray in the name of Jesus. This is because as we pray we are not only talking to God, but resisting the enemy, declaring truth, and claiming our families for Christ in the heavenly realms.

Each day you can praise the Lord that whatever is in that Scripture is for your family. Praise is an important part of our prayer because it helps us to put our trust in the Lord, welcoming the presence of God to fight for us. Praise and Scripture in our prayers terrify the enemy.

As we begin this 52 days we give our families to the Lord Jesus and invite Him to take His place as King over every person, relationship, behavior, wound, and circumstance—past present and future. You may even want to write some of these specifics down before you begin, writing Scriptures next to them as you go (see pages 56-59).



DAY
ONE

COLOSSIANS 1 (NIV)

¹⁶For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. ¹⁷He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.

Jesus, I praise You that all things in our family—and every person—are created through You and for You. I worship You as the maker of our family and the One who is worthy to be Lord over every part. I praise You that You are before all things in our family; in You, Jesus, all things hold together. I bow before You and declare that this family is not held together by any of us—nor by anyone else, not any tradition or history, but only by You, Lord.

Jesus, meet our family where we have lived as though we have to be in control; or where we have lived like our history, behaviors, wounds, or circumstances are before all things. Please forgive us, draw us to trust You, heal our hearts, and transform our thought patterns so that we welcome You to rule as Maker and Sustainer of every part of our family. Jesus take Your rightful place and hold all things together in Your power and love.



DAY
TWO

PSALM 9 (ESV)

⁷ But the Lord sits enthroned forever; he has established His throne for justice, ⁸ and he judges the world with righteousness; he judges the peoples with uprightness.

I praise You that You are the King who is enthroned forever. I declare You are King in this family. You come and rule over our history, every struggle, every relationship, every wound, every behavior, every emotion, every health challenge, and over our passions and hopes. Jesus, rule over any other spiritual force that is at work. Rule over our future. Lord, take the throne. Thank You that You rule in righteousness, and all Your judgements are good and upright for this family. You are the rightful King and Judge over our family and I welcome You to reign over every person and every part—past, present, and future.

DAY THREE

PHILIPPIANS 2 (NIV)

⁸ And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross! ⁹ Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Lord Jesus, I praise You that You died for my family and You are exalted to the highest place over every spiritual dominion and earthly power. I worship you, Jesus, name above every name, and I pray You will take Your place over the names of people, spiritual powers, or anything that has influenced my family. Forgive us for any way in which You have not been given the highest place. I surrender before You anything that our family has made our hope; anything we have given our hearts to, or loved more than you. Holy Spirit, show me anything that has been an idol in my family (*quietly listen*). Jesus, I cast down all idols of possessions, comforts, careers, culture, entertainment, sports, traditions, romance, happiness, or self under Your name, asking that everyone in our family will bow down with all their heart and confess that Jesus Christ is Lord to the glory of God the Father.

DAY FOUR

PSALM 89 (WEB)

¹⁴ Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne. Loving kindness and truth go before your face.

PSALM 45 (NIV)

⁴ In your majesty ride forth victoriously in the cause of truth, humility and justice; let your right hand achieve awesome deeds.

Lord, I praise You and thank You that You are the King who rides out in victory for truth, humility, and justice. Thank You that You see where there are distortions, pride, and lies and where injustice is at work in our family. You hate these things. Lord, show me what You see and lead me in how to pray. *(Be still and listen to what the Holy Spirit brings to mind and give those things to Jesus.)* Lord, bring all these under Your righteous rule and let Your right hand achieve awesome deeds in our family. Help us not to try to control ourselves by our hand, but to allow You to come and rule justly for us. Jesus, come and take Your throne, reigning over any other authority, personalities, spiritual powers, or emotions involved. Work justice by Your right hand. Show Your loving kindness to all involved. King of righteousness, lead our family in Your humility and truth.

FIVE

PSALM 24 (NIV)

⁷Lift up your heads, you gates; be lifted up, you ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in. ⁸Who is this King of glory? The LORD mighty in battle.

I worship You, King of glory, over the _____ family. Break down the gates and open the doors and come in. Holy Spirit, show me specific things from the past or even the present that may be blocking You from coming into every part of our family. (*Listen for specific things and ask the Lord to show you how to pray through each one.*) In Jesus' name, clear each block out of the way, break open the doors, and enter in to take Your rightful throne. I praise You that You are mighty in battle, and I ask You to fight for us today so that there will be nothing in our hearts, minds, relationships, behaviors, or circumstances that will block Your coming in. Jesus, strong and mighty, break the power of the enemy in our family wherever he would blind spiritual eyes, confuse, distort relationships, steal, or destroy. King of glory, come in and clear out any spiritual darkness that has been welcomed through reading or watching stories of occult, or supporting anything that promotes spiritual darkness. I pray the blood of Jesus over every place where a door has been opened to the evil one, and I invite You to close those doors. Come in and rule in this family.

LUKE 19(WEB)

¹⁰ For the Son of Man came to seek and to save that which was lost.

Thank You, Jesus, that You love _____ and do not want them to be far from You. Thank You that You came into the world to seek and save _____.

LUKE 15 (WEB)

⁴ Which of you men, if you had one hundred sheep, and lost one of them, wouldn't leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness, and go after the one that was lost, until he found it? ⁵ When he has found it, he carries it on his shoulders, rejoicing. ⁶ When he comes home, he calls together his friends and his neighbors, saying to them, "Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep..."

Jesus, I thank You for being the Good Shepherd. You will not give up searching for _____. I pray that _____ will see Your unfailing love for them and will allow You to find and carry them home.

But while he was still far off, his father saw him, and was moved with compassion, and ran, and fell on his neck, and kissed him.

I pray that _____ will become dissatisfied with where they are and recognize their hunger for You. Father, bring them to their senses and turn their hearts back to You. Bring them to a place where they are sorry and know that they need Your forgiveness. Jesus, give them the courage to turn back. Father, I thank You that You are waiting for _____ to come back. I pray that they will know You have a heart of compassion towards them. Break any lies they believe that tell them You will not love or accept them. Open their hearts to see You are ready to run to them, however far they have been from You. I pray that _____ will receive Your forgiveness and Your loving embrace.

DAY EIGHT

EPHESIANS 2 (WEB)

¹ You were made alive when you were dead in transgressions and sins, ² in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the children of disobedience; ³ among whom we also all once lived in the lust of our flesh, doing the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest. ⁴ But God, being rich in mercy, for his great love with which he loved us, ⁵ even when we were dead through our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved).

Thank You that Your great love and mercy are for _____. Oh Jesus, free _____ from the spirit of the enemy to whom they are not even aware they are listening. Jesus, show them that they are not free but are following the world and locked up in desires and sin. Open their hearts to see they are spiritually dead, and give them a longing to be made alive in You. Lord, I praise You that You can rescue _____ from the kingdom of darkness and bring them into the kingdom of Your Son. Thank You, Jesus, that You can redeem _____ and forgive them. Open their minds to see they need You to redeem, forgive and rescue them out of darkness.

COLOSSIANS 2 (NLT)

¹³ You were dead because of your sins and because your sinful nature was not yet cut away. Then God made you alive with Christ, for he forgave all our sins. ¹⁴ He canceled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross. ¹⁵ In this way, he disarmed the spiritual rulers and authorities. He shamed them publicly by His victory over them on the cross.
