Oliver's Training is named after Oliver McGowan whose death shone a light on the need for health and social care staff to have better training about the needs of autistic people and people with a learning disability.



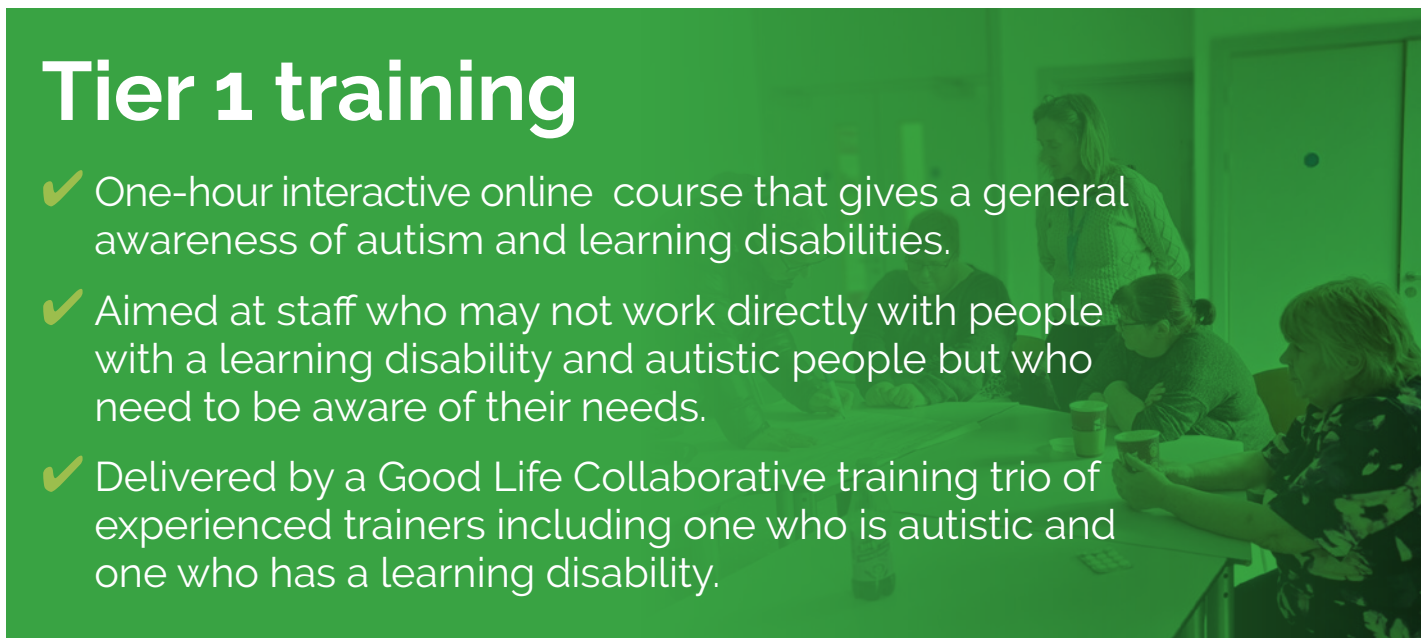

Staff training in learning disability and autism is a legal requirement for Care Quality Commission (CQC) regulated service providers. Oliver's Training is the government's preferred model.

Which courses are available?

Tier 1 training

- ✓ One-hour interactive online course that gives a general awareness of autism and learning disabilities.
- ✓ Aimed at staff who may not work directly with people with a learning disability and autistic people but who need to be aware of their needs.
- ✓ Delivered by a Good Life Collaborative training trio of experienced trainers including one who is autistic and one who has a learning disability.



Tier 2 training

- ✓ In-person full day session.
- ✓ Aimed at staff who are likely to engage with people with a learning disability or autistic people as part of their work (e.g. people in public/patient facing roles).
- ✓ Delivered by a Good Life Collaborative training trio of experienced trainers including one who is autistic and one who has a learning disability.

Trainer Training

- ✓ Bespoke sessions to train people with lived experience of learning disabilities and autism and support staff to become Expert Trainers and Facilitators.
