#### **Brian Nuss: Heavenly Lake Tahoe Trip - CANCELED**

While the pandemic remains a concern for group travel, and various restrictions remain fluid due to constantly changing conditions, I have decided to cancel the Heavenly Lake Tahoe trip due to the Operational Plans announced by Vail Resorts in September. Vail Resorts will not honor group lift tickets and mandates all trip participants purchase an EPIC pass to guarantee access to Snowsports activities during the length of the stay. This mandate forces all trip participants to incur additional costs, while also mandating pass holders reserve ski days in advance. This not only presents a logistical challenge - it adds costs to the trip which is not negotiable, nor is it acceptable.

I pride myself in running the best trip possible at the best price possible to provide value to those that travel with me. While I have remained confident the trip would be enjoyable for those attending even in the midst of the confusion and concern of the pandemic, I find it challenging to offer value based on Vail's corporate decisions and directions which caters only to "their members" and seemingly deters group travel. I look forward to identifying a 2022 destination early next year and look forward to those wishing to travel with me in the future.
