#### 2025 Colorado Ski Trip

Mark Baechle escorted 20 skiers to 3 ski resorts in Colorado from March 1—8, 2025 – Breckenridge, Keystone, and Vail. We stayed at the Ski-In/Ski-Out Beaver Run Resort, at the Beaver Run Superchair. The resort had multiple bars and restaurants, indoor/outdoor pools, 7+ hot tubs, an arcade, miniature golf, and condos with full kitchens, living rooms, fireplaces, balconies, and large bedrooms.

We had blue sky and sunshine for our first two days. Those "bluebird" days gave us beautiful scenery, and miles of smiles. We woke up the third morning to 7" of fresh powder. Many of us had untracked snow, top to bottom that morning. The next morning, we woke up to another 7" (wow, 14")! We had even more snow the next day, and the next day. Just as we though "that is what a ski trip should be", the sunshine the last day reminded us that bluebird days are great also.

Mark hosted parties almost every day. Included were a Mardi Gras Party, a Pizza Party, a Finale Party, [a pre-Party & a Post Party], and his famous Son-of-a-Beach Party. There was plenty of beer, wine, food, and fun. All parties provided a way for folks to meet new friends, and plan to ski with others. Mark will deny that there may or may not have been "luggage cart races" up and down the halls.

The folks that took the free bus to Keystone were impressed with how big it was, with tons of great skiing. Mark drove skiers to Vail on Thursday, in blue sky and sunshine. Once we got to Game Creek Bowl, the snow started moving in. At lunch we checked the weather radar and discovered a huge snow storm heading toward us. Even though we were enjoying great snow at Vail, we "high-tailed it" down to our vehicle, so we could get over Vail Pass before they closed it. By the time we reached our 4WD Tahoe, they had instituted chain requirement for all commercial vehicles, and 4WD & snow tire (which we had) requirements for non-commercial. The drive over the pass was slow, but we made it back to Beaver Run, and enjoyed beverages in the hot tub, while we told our tale of our 4 hours of skiing at Vail.
