PSC Scholarship Applicant Income Limit Table*

Objective: To steer program to those most in "need" considering the geographical economy

* School free lunch program automatically qualifies a student applicant'

Note: Based upon family of three, the average household size in this valley rounded up (although household not technically a family), therefore have greatest weight on median incomes

Note: Use of average income will likely overweight to those not in need. Seeking around and the lower half of the economic scale (eye towards bootstrapping)

Note: Scale algorithm based upon Florida's Step-Up Scholarship Program

Note: Scale is for receiving full amount of scholarship, lesser amounts can be given

Note: Five year looks are used for federal planning typically, as margin of error lowers? Definitely conservative

Program's Median Household Income: \$ 67,565

Taken from one of the figures below, after looking at ranging; changes table below

Median Household Income: \$ 67,565 Use higher of two counties, Northampton is generally wealthier by a few thousand; seems a happy medium for planning

Persons per Household: 3

Actually in the 2.5 range currently

Poverty Threshold \$ 21,720 for the 48 contiguous states; a not making it indicator

3X Poverty Threshold \$ 65,160

An approximation what is needed to live comfortably based upon the idea HUD takes 30% of median income to determine the low income level
