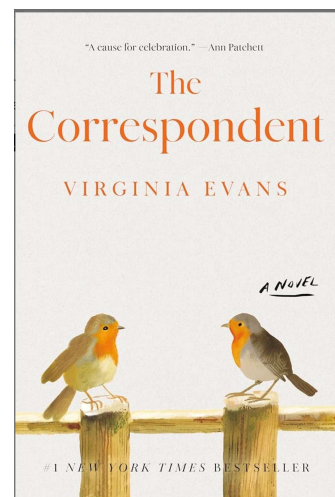
The Correspondent

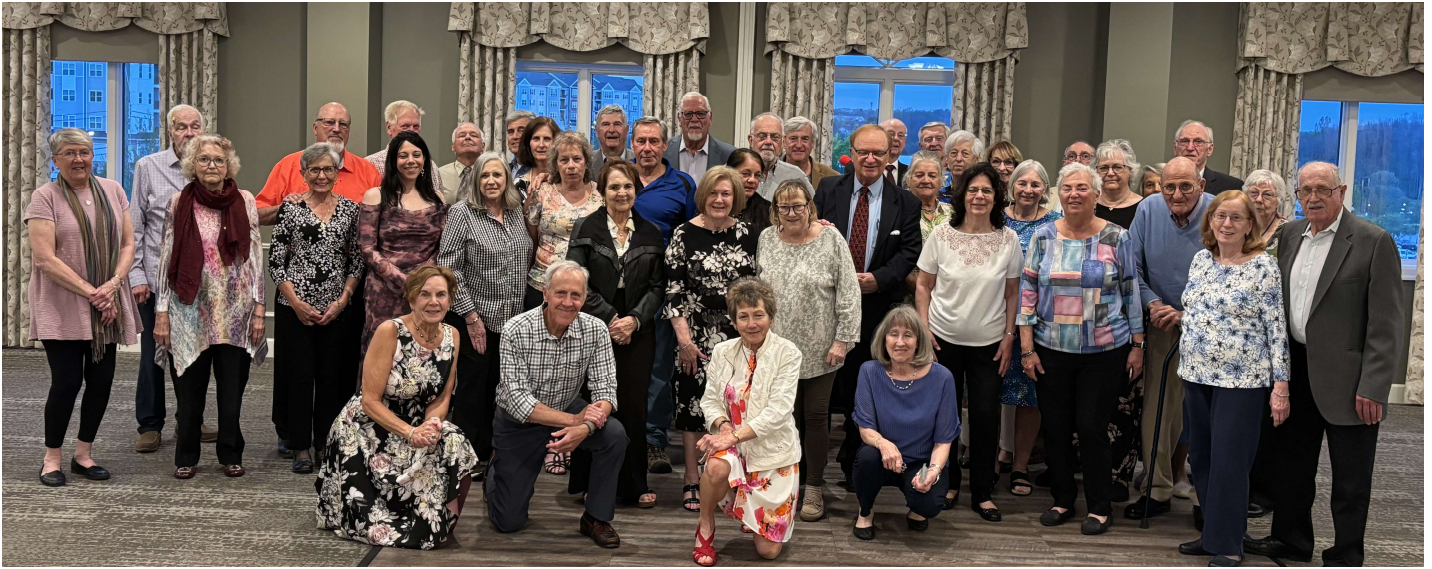
