





### **KIDSIGHT**



The Minnesota State Fair is now history and our 5th year at the Health Fair 11 building has concluded. It was the hottest and dirtiest, driest state fair on record. We screened 3,104 kids, with 350 referrals for an 11% referral rate. We surpassed our prior best year, 2019, by 102 kids. Many thanks to the Lions and friends who gave of their time and put up with the heat and dust to get this done. We had Lions from the St Louis Park, Hamel, Maple Grove, Hopkins, Bloomington, Brooklyn Park, Downtown Next Generation, Minneapolis Ambassadors, Edina, Osseo, Minneapolis Northside Roaring Lions, and Minneapolis

Southwest Clubs participate in screenings. Thank you!!

Lions from Edina, Maple Grove, Robbinsdale and St Louis Park participated in a screening event for the MN Vision Health Task Force which is focusing on vision health in the Indigenous population. We spent a day at Baby's Space preschool and childcare located in Little Earth Early Learning Center. We screened 47 kids with 17 referrals which is a little higher referral percentage. Thanks to Lions John Leroy, Tim Conaway, Coleen and Kenn Patterson for participating in this event.

Great news – From PDG Dennis Kelly, MD5M KidSight Chair: "It is with great pleasure and pride that I am informing you that MD5M finished in the top 10 Multiple Districts in this year's KidSight USA contest "Project See Clearly 2022". Congratulations to you and all of your dedicated Lions that made this happen. You are truly the best!!!!"



KidSight USA has announced the top 3 clubs in each multiple districts for the 2022-23 contest. Congratulations to the following clubs for their outstanding performance supporting the MD5M Lions KidSight Program.

Spring Lake Park, 5M7 Grand Rapids Cap Baker, 5M10 Princeton, 5M8

Each club will be receiving a banner patch to recognize this achievement. Wouldn't it be great if a club in 5M5 could be in the top 3 next year???

We've been busy screening at city events this summer. It was HOT at "Schooner Days" in Eden Prairie, but we still screened 89 kids with 5 referrals. We competed with the "Teddy Bear Band" at "Rockin Rogers" and we screened 40 kiddos with 1 referral. St Louis Park's "Parktacular" tallied 71 screens with 3 referrals. We had great fun screening at the Farmers Markets in Bloomington, another first, screening 89 kids with 5 referrals and 52 kids with 11 referrals at the second market.

### **KIDSIGHT** (continued)

We were at the Maple Grove Days (82 screened, 21 referrals), Mpls. NE Clubs Village Fest in St Anthony (45 screened, 0 referrals), the Brooklyn Center Community Health Fair (25 screened, 5 referrals), Robbinsdale Public Works Open House (88 screened 11 referrals) Richfield Unity In the Community (82 screened, 21 referrals), Brooklyn Park Back to School BBQ (80 screened 16 referrals), Osseo Lions Roar (48 screened 0 referrals), Brooklyn Park Waffle Breakfast (26 Screened 5 referrals) the Northside Lions Open Street event(56 screened, 12 referrals), and St Louis Park Fire Dept. Open House where we screened 87 Kiddos, 5 referrals in just 2 hours. Add some preschools to make it a VERY busy summer. Thank you to all the Lions that made this possible.

Stats for the last Lions year, from July 1 to June 30, showed we screened **3927** kids, doubling last year's total with **369** referrals. Amazing! 369 kids that we found possible abnormalities.... and will get help to see clearly,

Remember to put KidSight on your planning calendar. There are so many children that we haven't reached in our district and in your clubs' area. We can and need to give every child the opportunity to see clearly. Get involved, learn to screen, help with events and at schools, and encourage your club to participate. We're here to help you. Contact us!

#### Selection Criteria

#### Selection Process:

- 1. One or two awards may be presented annually to Lions who have been members for five years or more.
- 2. The candidates' selection must be bases only on contributions at a District or Multiple level.
- 3. Each District Governor shall annually nominate no more than one Lion to receive the award.
- 4. The nomination must be on the official nomination form, signed by the District Governor and submitted to the Council Chair each year no later than March 1.
- Final selection of the award recipients shall be made by a committee of the seated Council Chair and the two previous Council Chairs.

<u>Selection Criteria:</u> -The award shall be presented to the most qualified Lions nominated for the award, based on the following criteria:

#### Leadership Characteristics:

- 1. Vision... The ability to see or seek out new ideas and new ways to advance the humanitarian service of Lionism
- Creativity...Can see new ways to solve problems and to provide humanitarian service. Willingly solicits new ideas from others and helps implement the ideas without worrying about who shall get credit.
- Courage... Follows through on commitments or a project no matter how difficult it may be. Openly
  accepts feedback, both complementary and critical, and is able to use the feedback to improve the overall
  success of the work.
- Initiative... Willing to step up and make things happen. Accepts assignments when asked and volunteers
  where needed. Makes things happen and gets things done.
- 5. Unselfishness... Contributes without expecting something in return. Is most interested in the success of the work and the recognition of those who contributed to the success. Finds satisfaction in the success of the work and the people served, not in the power base that may be gained.
- 6. Teamwork... Success in organizing a team, delegating work within the team, assuring that all members of the team are informed and committed, and follows through to make sure that the work of the team is successful. Also the ability to listen, take suggestions or directions, communicate, and work successfully as a member of a team.
- Effectiveness in leading others... Motivates others to be part of a project/ piece of work, gives them clearly defined recognition when the project/work is completed.
