You qualify for RLLI training if you:

- ou quality for RLLI training it you: are a current member in good standing have an interest in becoming a better Lions member. meeting other Lions and sharing ideas have not attended RLLI in the past five years. like having FUN!!!

- RLLI Participants are required to:
- Attend all sessions of the three-day institute.
 You may commute to RLU if you attend all sessions and can do so safely.
 Complete pre-assignments prior to beginning of RLU.
 Pay \$150 participation fee.
- Participants who complete all sessions and required assignments will receive a \$100 rebate upon completion of RLLI.
