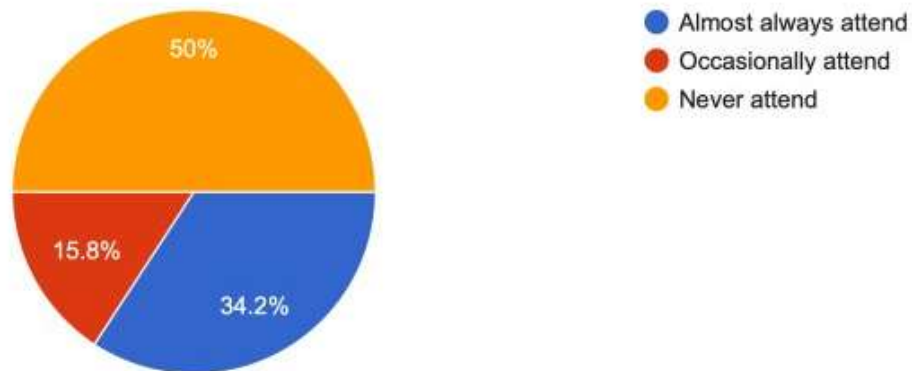

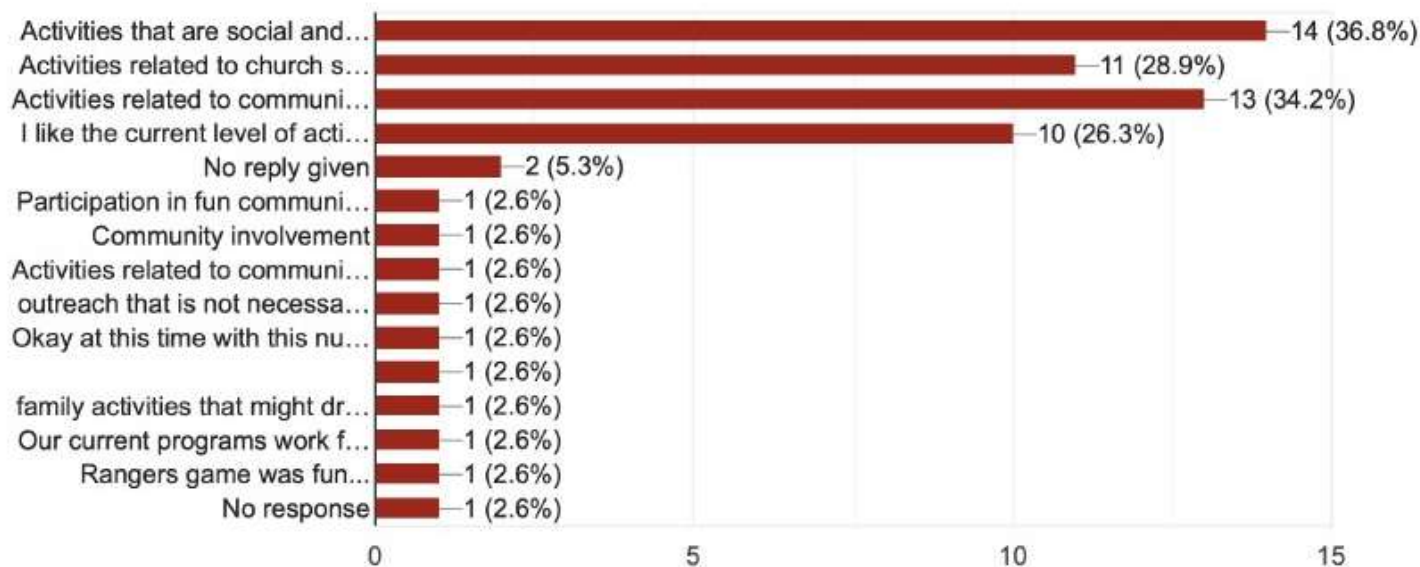

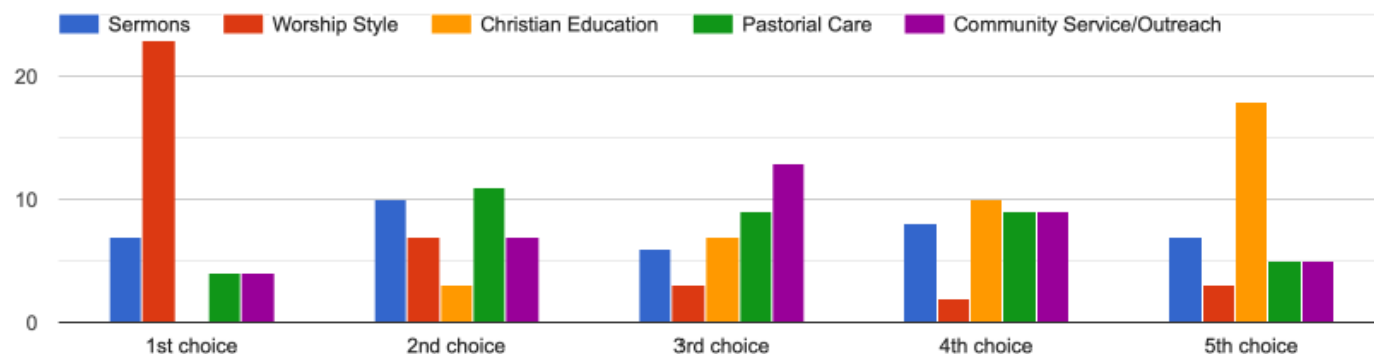

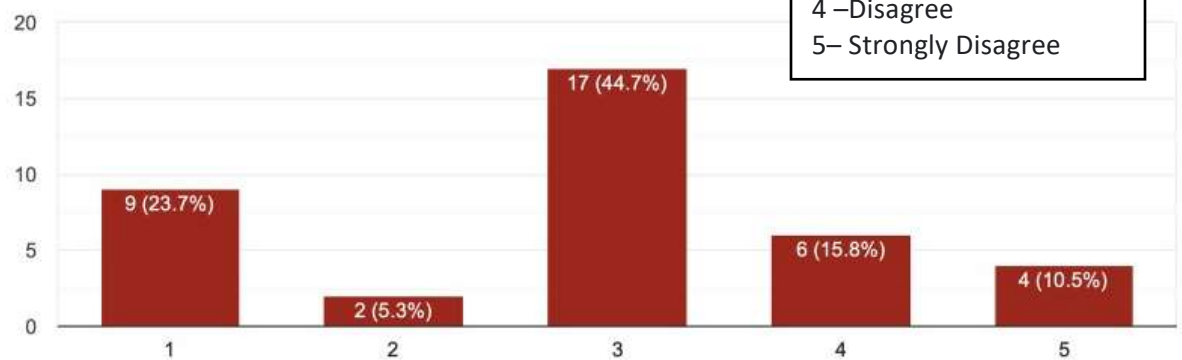

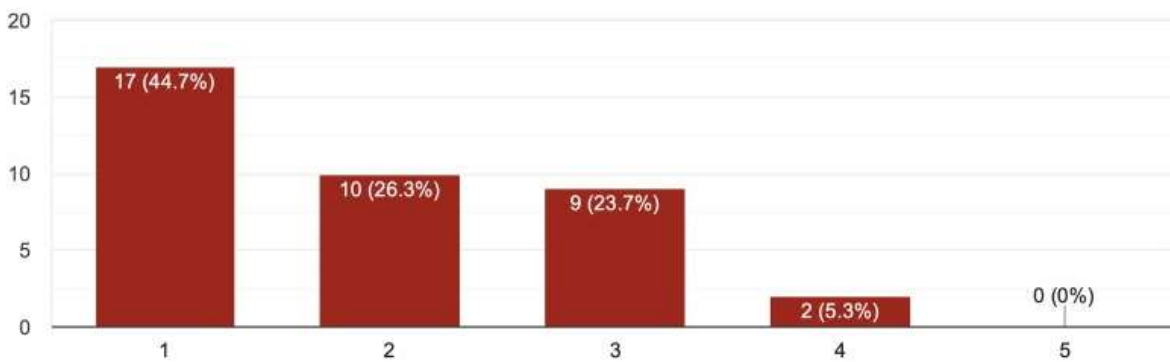

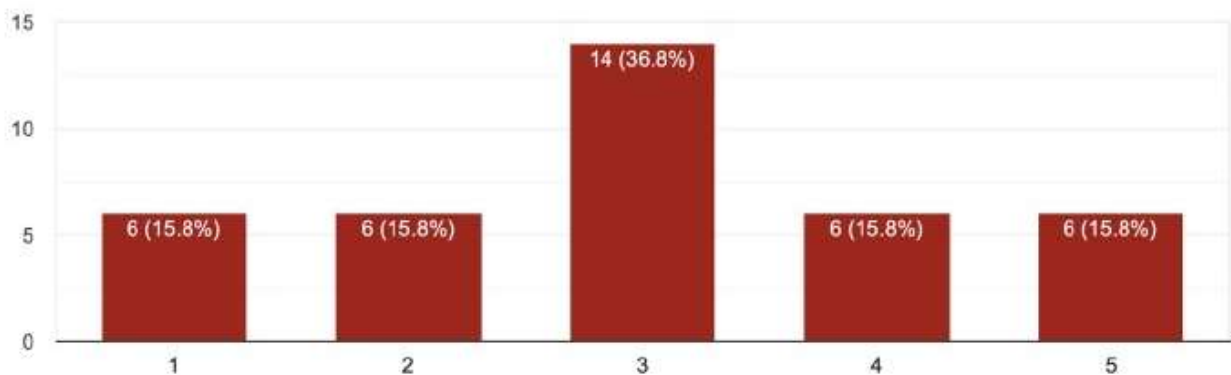
Q38 I am most comfortable with a Rite II service

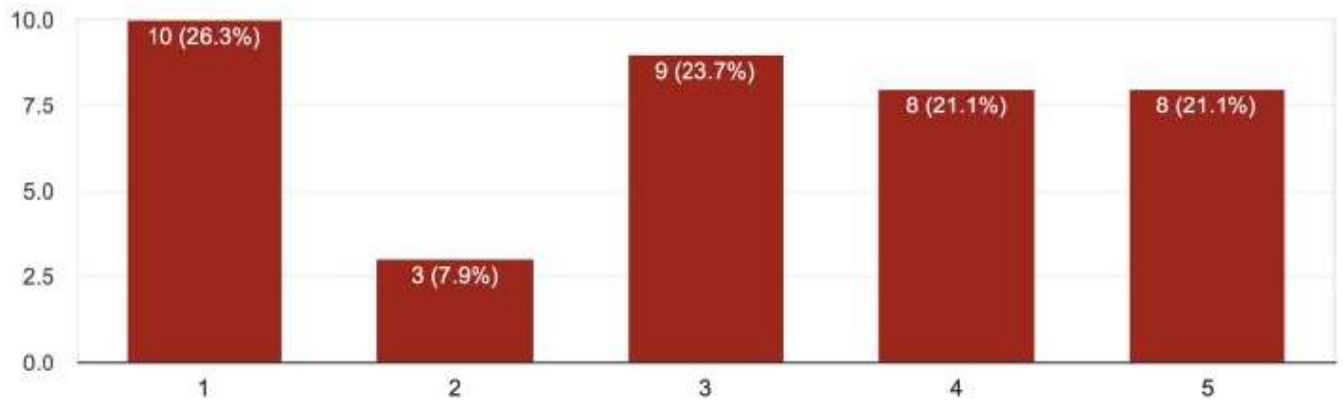

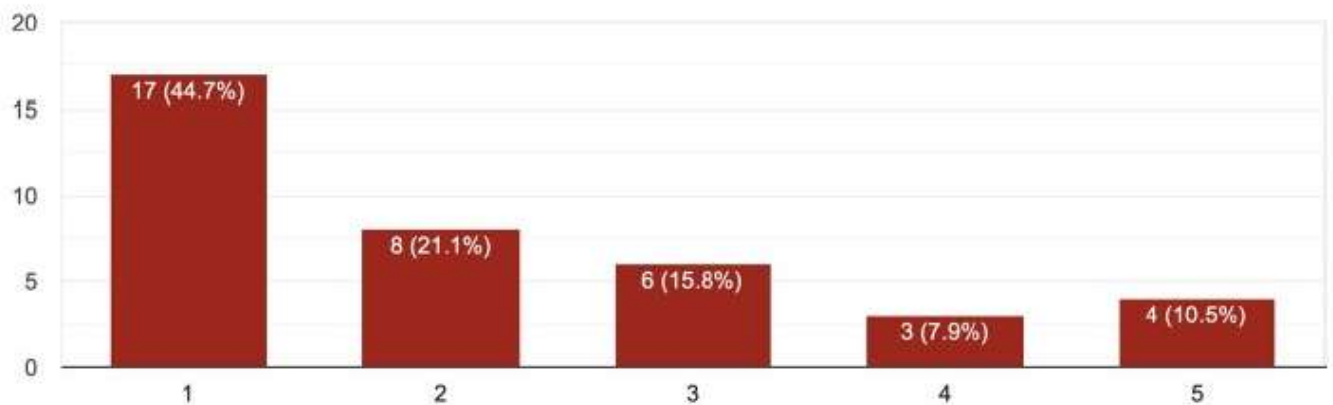

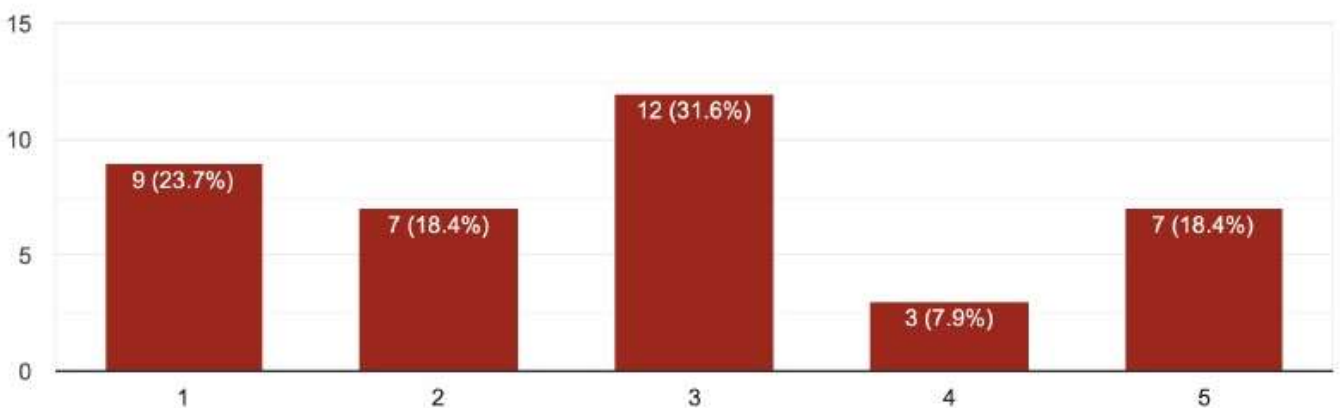

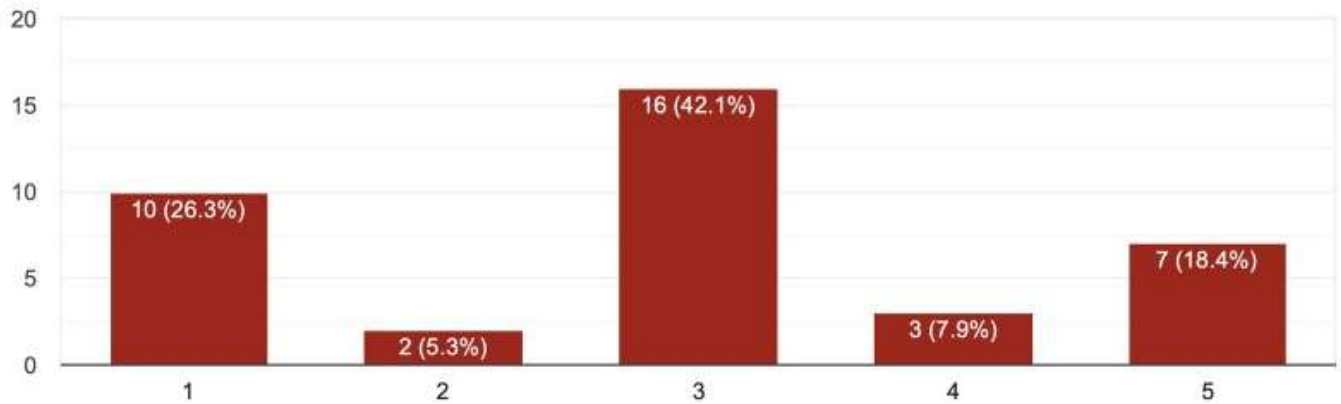

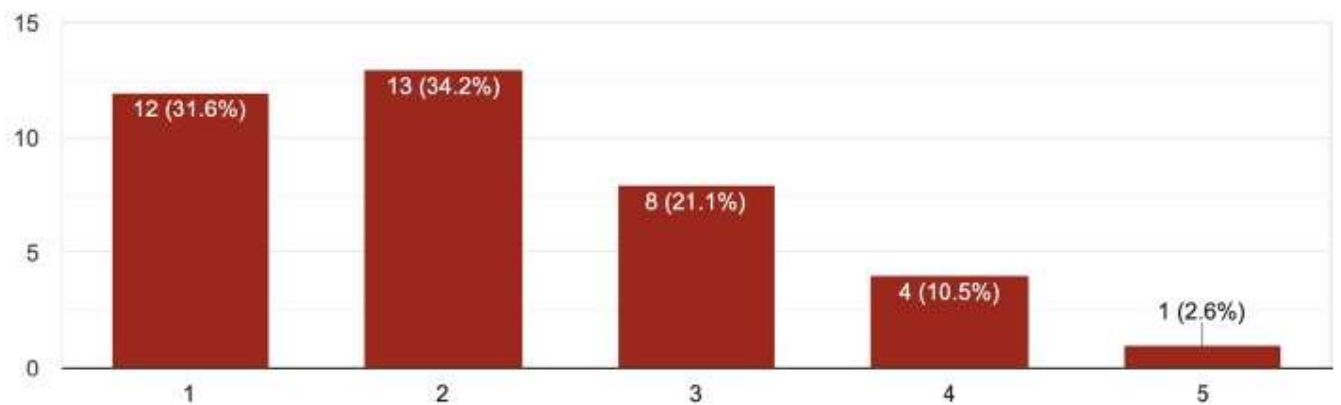

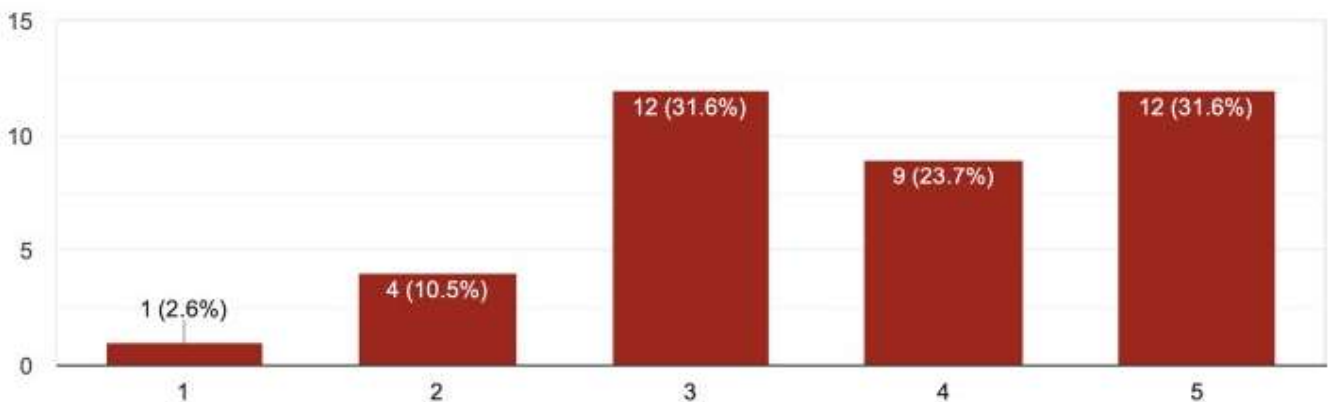

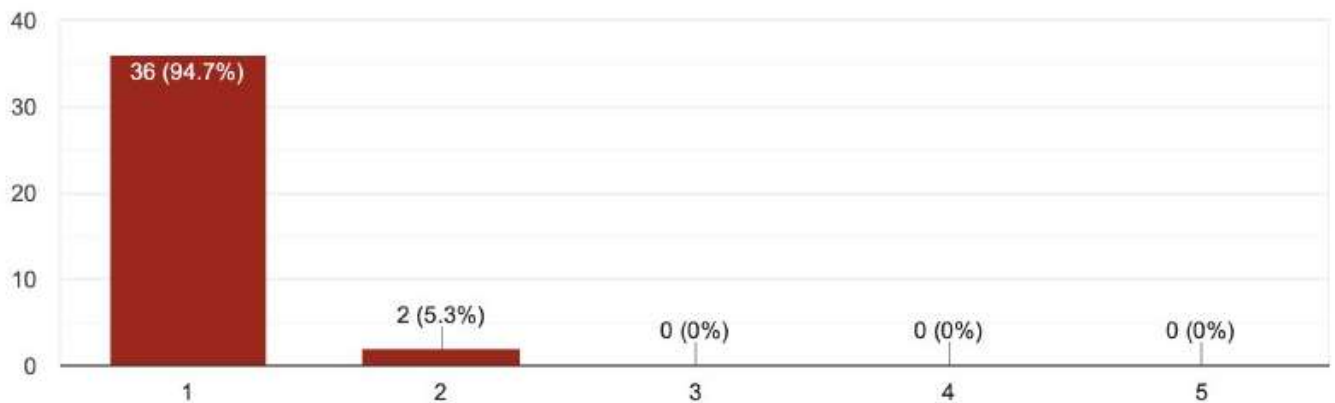

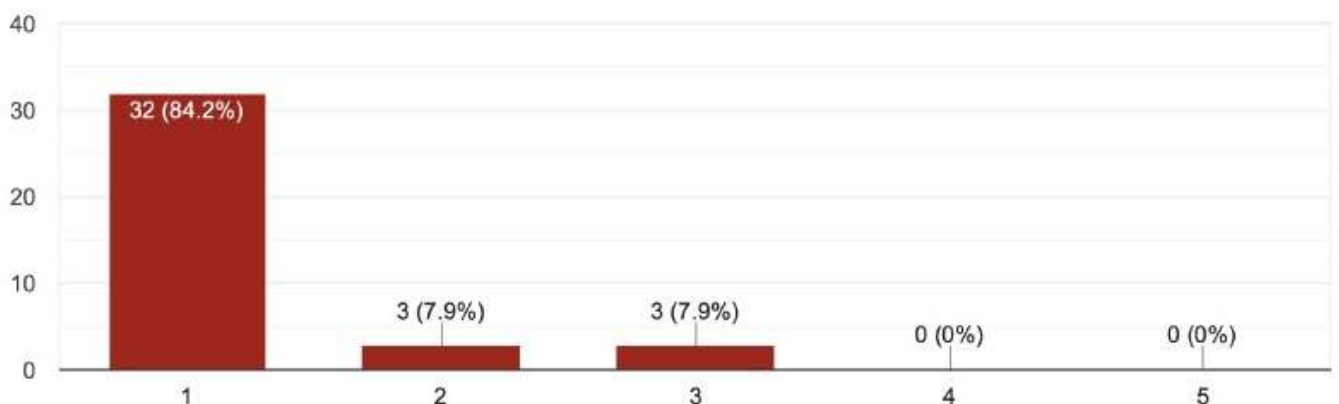

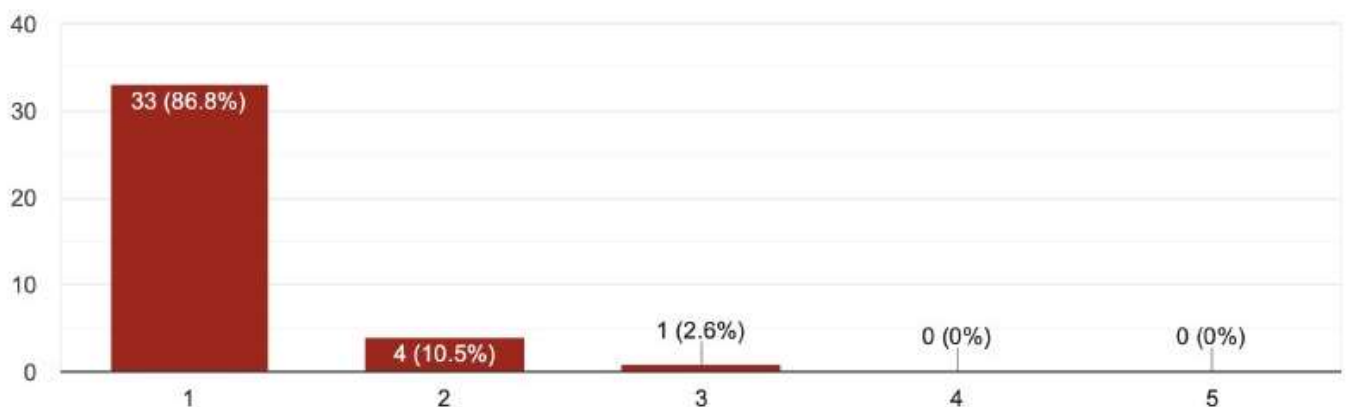

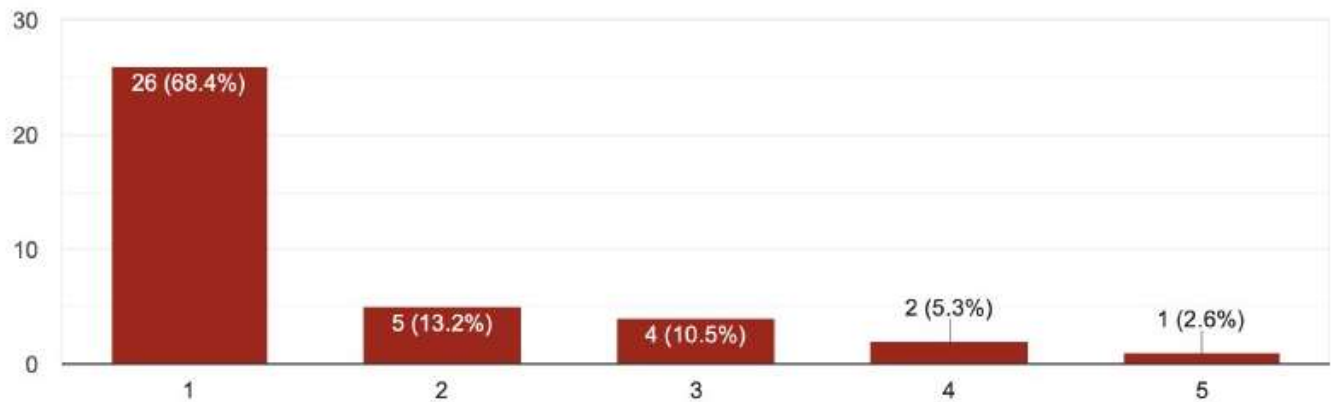

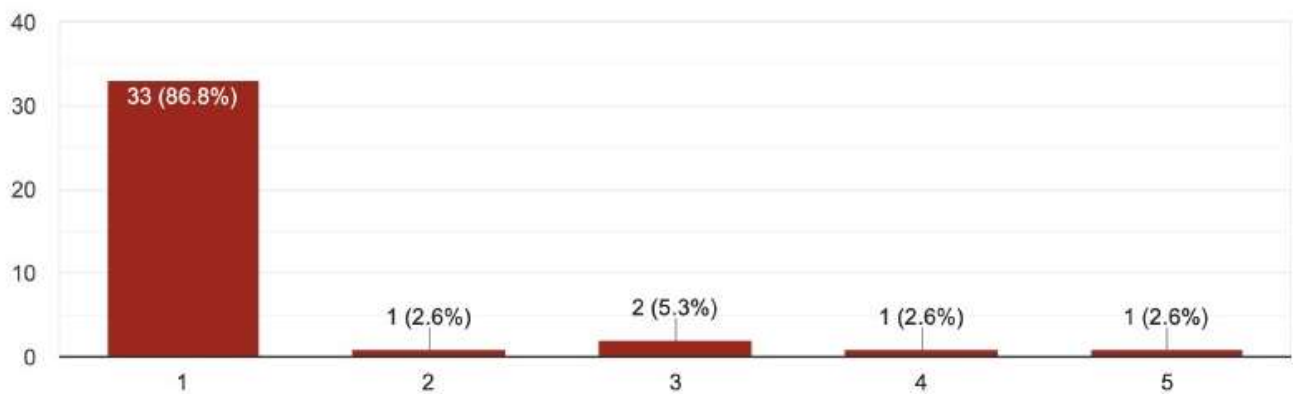

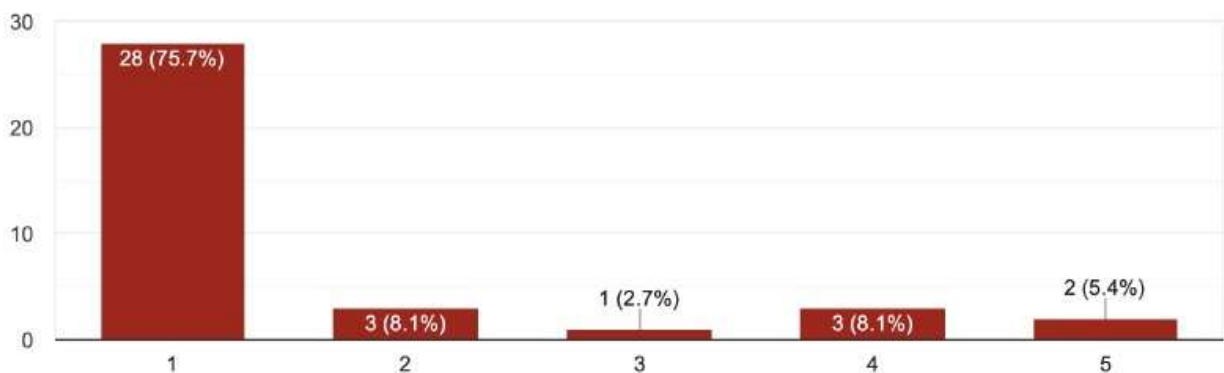
Q52 I would support St. Barnabas's calling a woman as rector.

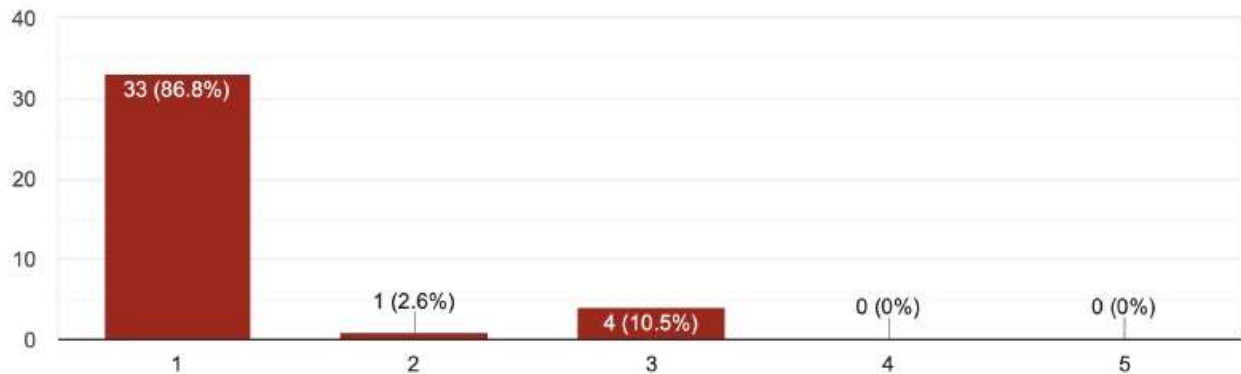

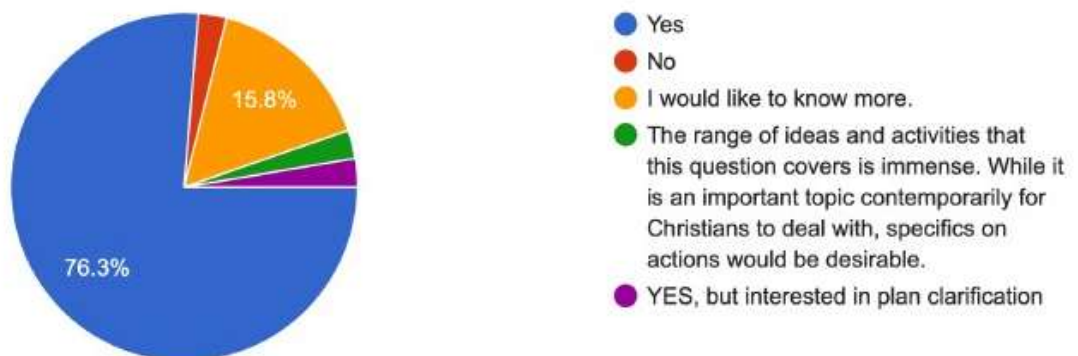

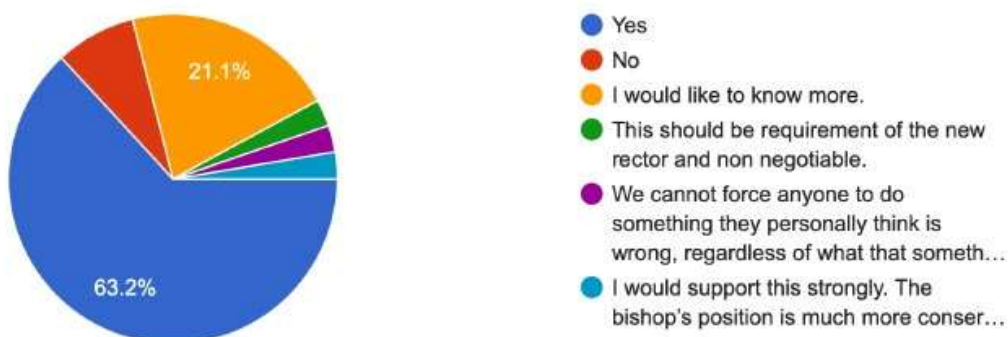
