



**"Abundance"**  
**John 6:1-15**

**Math on the hillside =====>**

**5 loaves + 2 fish = 5000+ meals**  
**5000+ meals divided by 12 baskets = Abundance**

**Principles from the Hillside =====>**

- 1. Jesus will use our obedience in the natural realm to move in the supernatural. (verses 5-10)**
- 2. When we take what little we have in our hands and put it in the hands of Jesus, He can make much out of little. (verse 11)**
- 3. Jesus provides both enough, and in abundance. (verses 12-13)**
- 4. Jesus invites us to embrace Him as the King of our heart, not a King in a forced position of authority. (verses 14-15)**

**John 10:10b – "I have come, that you may have life, and have it more abundantly."**
