From The Pastor...

“A Global Church”

When Tuscumbia First Methodist Church joined the Global Methodist Church in 2022, we joined an organization with a Mission Statement that was simple, “Worship Passionately, Witness Boldly, and Love Extravagantly.” Realistically, it stated what we were going to do. In September, 2024, in Costa Rica at the historic Convening General Conference of the GMC we adopted a Mission Statement which articulated why we exist. It is a truer Mission Statement. Still simple, but deep and rich in meaning. Theologically rooted. Theologically Wesleyan. Biblically true.

“The Global Methodist Church exists to make disciples of Jesus Christ and spread scriptural holiness across the globe.”

With this Mission Statement, two very important parts of my life came together to walk side by side. I am aligned with a denomination who reflects the passion of my heart and I am serving a great church who lives out this mission statement with passion. As you know, globally means Jerusalem (local), Judea and Samaria (national), and to the ends of the earth (international).

From the Colbert Caring Center just a few blocks down the street, to Africa or Romania some 6,000 miles in a different part of the world, we are truly a global church. As we approach our Global Impact Celebration, let me remind you that we support 8 local mission partners, 8 national mission partners, and 16 international mission partners. Additionally, we support mission teams, seminary education, and disaster relief which reaches each of these different areas. It is an incredible testimony of how global we are at heart.

Many of these Mission Partners will be with us during our Celebration. Two local partners will be joining us on Sunday, February 1, during Sunday School to share about what God has been doing through their ministry. We will see videos from two or three others. During the weekend of February 5-8, we will experience about 24 more Mission Partners. It is important for you to participate as much as possible. Lori and I will be at the church or hosting a partner for a dinner conversation on Saturday night from the opening song on Friday evening to the closing time with our partners on Sunday afternoon. You should join us for a unique experience that will change your life. It’s a full weekend but one full of reward and blessing. Join me as we think globally together.

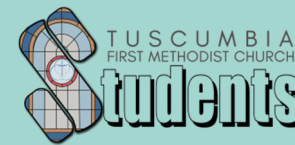
