





# From The Pastor...

#### So Many Magazines

Lori and I have for several years had a Post Office box rather than having mail delivered to our home for a lot of different reasons. It simply worked better for us. We have one now in Tuscumbia as a temporary solution but will soon begin having mail delivered to our house. (After we get a mailbox.) With the popularity and ease of receiving various pieces of communication via email or online accounts and going paperless, the amount of mail delivered to us has decreased dramatically over the years. That is, until recently. When I was approaching sixty-five years of age, our box became inundated with mail related to Medicare and it hasn't let up. The end result is that I might go to the Post Office to pick up our mail once or twice a week. I do this because we receive very little "important" mail which is time sensitive.

A large portion of the mail we receive are magazines related to retail companies. They have slowed down some but we still get plenty. And oddly, when I say we still get plenty, many of them are multiple, duplicate magazines from the same company. Their marketing strategy must involve the number of magazines delivered directly influences the buyer. I think the opposite is true for me. They become familiar and I assume I've already seen it and I toss it in the trash on the way out. I might miss something great, maybe a terrific bargain, because I assume I'm familiar with the contents. Tossing is easy and has become a habit of mine.

We judge easily and "toss" quickly in our fast-paced culture. Don't let this mentality spill over into your spiritual life. It is quite unhealthy if we think we are so familiar with the scriptures we "toss it" and never explore the contents. Or we assume we are familiar enough with prayer we "toss it" and never spend time in the presence of the One who authored the contents. There are so many things we "toss" in our spiritual journey because of perceived familiarity. Don't make this mistake. Open every piece of scripture, prayer, worship, acts of service, fellowship, etc., and see what is inside. You will be amazed at how

it is ever changing in meaning. Ever transforming. New nuggets of truth jumping off the page like never before.

You see, when we get in the habit of opening instead of tossing, we expect something worthwhile to be inside. Intentionality leads to expectation which leads to discovery of the goodness of God. Open. Don't toss the gifts God has given so we might enjoy intimacy with Him.
