The purpose of the center is to unite churches, institutions, organizations, and businesses in the coordinated assistance and ministry to those in need. The center provides assistance with utility bills and food from our pantry. The food from the pantry consists of canned goods, peanut butter & jelly, and boxed food items. We also have a diaper ministry in partnership with a local church which donates diapers and wipes for our clients who are in need of these.


Prayer Needs:

We have developed a partnership between North Alabama and Nigeria which will hopefully be a long term relationship. We met the Nigerians at the General Conference in 2012 in Tampa. When we asked them what they needed, Johnwesley Yohanna said that they needed a comprehensive secondary school in Karim Maundi, Nigeria, in the Taraba State. We have been building a partnership since then to build the buildings and equip the trade school aspect of the education. The school offers both tracks of academics and practical skill education. After the school is complete, the partnership will consider other missions and projects in the Central Conference of the United Methodist Church in Nigeria.
