Ministry Description

SIFAT (Servants in Faith and Technology) is a nonprofit Christian organization that provides training in community development in hard places in our world. Christian leaders learn self-help skills for basic humanneeds including physical, spiritual, social and economic needs. We call this Sharing God's Love in Practical Ways.

SIFAT raises awareness of needs and global issues while providing opportunities for people to get involved personally, both to learn from and to serve alongside those with scarce resources. Since its founding in 1979, SIFAT has trained church and community leaders from more than 90 countries. We have helped thousands of North Americans leave their comfort zone, cross into other cultures and become one in Christ.

Mission Statement: To share God's love through service, education and personal involvement with a needy world.

Praises:

- 1. In Costa Rica, we completed phase one renovations on our Central American Training Center's existing facilities for training events for community leaders from South America, Central America and the Caribbean. During the summer, four interns from the national agricultural university in Honduras developed ag demonstrations, installed appropriate technology examples and taught seminars for the local community.
- 2. SIFAT's Learn & Serve campus programs had a successful Summer Experience, our first since COVID.
- 3. International mission teams returned to Ecuador and Bolivia. In Ecuador, *The Golden Bread* continues to provide food for the elderly in Atucucho, where we served for many years and to our Aida Leon project, where teams served prior to COVID. Our international graduate project committee raised more than \$49,000 to fully fund eight large projects and two small projects.
- 4. We continued to be blessed by our partner churches and individual donors' generosity, whose gifts allow SIFAT to keep Sharing God's Love in Practical Ways.

- To safely continue welcoming groups for Learn & Serve programming this year.
- To recruit more teams to serve in Ecuador and for fundraising and safe travel for our teams planning trips
- To find in-country vendors and finalize logistics to begin taking teams to Costa Rica in late 2023.
- For our training graduates and their ministries serving communities around the world.
- For our staff's health and wellness, so that we are effectively Sharing God's Love in Practical Ways.
