

Here are some family conversation starters to accompany the movie *Finding Dory*.

1. What made Dory different from her friends? What are some ways God made you different from your friends?

Emphasize that God made each of us different. For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother's womb. I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well. *Psalm 139:13-14* 

2. What/Who was Dory looking for? Her home/parents

3. How did you feel when Dory saw the seashells leading her home? How does God give us shells to point us back to Him? What are some of those shells in your life?

*This provides an easy, open door for you to discuss the great love you have for your littles and how God's love is exponentially far more than they can imagine.*
