

## 2024 High School Guidelines

### General Information

- Entry Fee is \$75
- Entry fee is non-refundable/non-transferable once a team is accepted into a tournament
- Partner changes are due 3 weeks prior to first day of competition, no partner changes after, if someone cannot fish within 3 weeks of the tournament then their partner fishes alone.
- Boat captain changes due at latest 10 days prior to the tournament.
- If a team is on the wait list, they can cancel at any time and receive a full refund of their entry fee
- Any team not accepted into a tournament off the waiting list will be canceled the week of the tournament after registration and will be refunded.
- All refunds will be paid back to the card used for the entry fee unless B.A.S.S. is notified that the card has been canceled/expired, and then a refund check will be processed.
- Full field for each tournament is 250 teams
- All cancellations, refund requests and waiting list cancellations must be submitted via email to [highschool@bassmaster.com](mailto:highschool@bassmaster.com)

### Registration

- All anglers must have an active B.A.S.S. membership and B.A.S.S. Nation membership. Make sure your memberships are current prior to registration.
- All entries based on timestamp. First come, first served.

### Waivers & Tax Paperwork

- Each angler must complete a waiver and W9 prior to practice
- The waiver and W9 are combined document to be completed through our online e-signature company.
- The waiver and W9 document is a two-step process to be completed first by the parent/guardian and then by the angler.
- The boat captain must complete a waiver
- The waiver/W9 document only needs to be completed once per season.

### 2024 High School Championship Qualifications

- Top 10% from each B.A.S.S. run High School Opens tournament qualify for championship
- Each state with an active B.A.S.S. Nation that has a minimum of 60 members is allotted two (2) berths. Any state with an active B.A.S.S. Nation with less than 60 members will receive 1 berth to the National Championship to be given away at the State Championship.
- Each high school team trail will receive entries based on their participation. Please consult your sanctioned team trail director for more information.

- The top two (2) finishers from each Bassmaster High School Open
- The Junior National Champion Winners
