Activity		Measures in Effect on 23 August 2021
Academic Activity...	... on Main Campuses	Course delivery plan for Fall 2021 communicated
	... in study spaces	Laid out to enforce physical distancing
	... in our Libraries	Thompson and The Pas: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Masks and physical distancing (same as all of UCN) - Students sign in as they enter the library - Capacity cap of 25% - Circulated items sanitized or quarantined - Inter-library loans are allowed NEW! Community libraries: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Follow directions of each community and/or UCN protocols whichever is more restrictive/safer
	...in PSEACs and other off-main campus locations	Respect restrictions of the home community, and/or follow UCN protocols where those protocols are more restrictive/safer.
	... at Mary Duncan School	The ECE program at MDS will follow the guidelines established by MDS, or UCN guidelines, whichever are stricter.
	Camps and field trips	Day camps are allowed with restrictions on food service, limiting provision of food to individually wrapped items and bottled water. No smorgasbord-style service allowed. NEW! Overnight camps are allowed with a maximum capacity of 15 participants and approval of a plan by Public Health and an operating permit received in advance from Public Health. Restrictions apply to food service, limiting provision of food to individually wrapped items and bottled water. No smorgasbord-style service allowed. NEW!
Facilities	Main campuses – public access	UCN open to only students, faculty, and staff.
	Physical Distancing	Physical distancing enforced throughout the campus. Furniture spaced out, computer labs adjusted, Plexiglas and other barriers put in place, directional markers placed on floors and doors. Reduced capacity limitations to be observed.
	Face Coverings	Face coverings mandatory for all students, visitors, faculty, and staff coming into a UCN facility.
	Cafeteria (TP)	Food handling to be in accordance with provincial regulations Dining hall to follow rules for non-licensed restaurants (the changes in the current health order allows diners from different households to be seated together unmasked. Diners may not circulate among tables. See Public Health Order 6. NEW!

	Fitness Centres	Physical distancing and masks continue to be required in the aerobics room and weight room in The Pas.
	The Pas gym	Follow public health orders for gymnasiums
	Student Housing	Carroll Hall at single occupancy. No specific restrictions for family or apt. style student housing
	Water coolers, shared coffee service, microwaves.	May be used in staff and student shared spaces. Must be wiped down with antiseptic wipes after each individual use. NEW!
	Use of checklists for instructors	Faculty are to use checklists prior to the outset of each class to support contact tracing and to ensure safety in the classroom
	PPE	Gloves, face shields required in specific circumstances. Safety glasses, face shields required in labs and shops
	Cleaning and disinfection	Increased cleaning regimen Shared items removed Hand sanitizer stations distributed throughout UCN's facilities Disinfecting wipes and other cleaning tools provided to staff and distributed to locations throughout UCN's facilities
	Hygiene	Guidance provided re personal hygiene
	Vaccination	As of November 1, 2021, all students, faculty, staff, and visitors must be vaccinated if they attend a UCN facility. Students who do not need to attend a UCN facility to pursue their studies, and faculty and staff authorized to not attend a UCN facility in the execution of their duties do not require vaccination. NEW!
Human Resources	Working from Home	Maximize the number of faculty and staff working from home, determined by supervisor based on operational requirements
	Daily self-screening	Staff required to use self-screening app daily before coming to a UCN facility (paper based for some).
	Training requirements	Online, self-led trg provided on cleaning, use of masks, etc.
	Protocols for when visitor, student, faculty or staff contract COVID-19	Protocols / checklists available to guide response and self-isolation / quarantine requirements.
Regional and Remote Campuses	General	Respect the restrictions of the home community and/or UCN protocols, whichever is more restrictive/safer. Individual plans are in place for PSEACs and other locations

Student Life	Orientation	Online orientation provided
	Student supports	Online, phone, and remote services continue to be available, but physically distanced in-person services may be offered with appointments NEW!
	Writing centres	Online, phone, and remote services continue to be available, but physically distanced in-person services may be offered with appointments NEW!
	Mama/ IK centres	No ceremonies provided. Open the centres to maximum capacities identified in <i>Sharing Space Safely</i> NEW!
	LACs	Online, phone, and remote services continue to be available, but physically distanced in-person services may be offered with appointments NEW!
	Accessibility Services	Online, phone, and remote services continue to be available, but physically distanced in-person services may be offered with appointments NEW!
	Student screening	Students self-screen. Posters provided at entrance ways.
	International students	Follow guidelines provided by Government of Canada.
Travel	UCN Travel Restrictions	Travel restricted to that which is absolutely necessary. Approval required by supervisor.
	Fleet vehicles	One person per UCN vehicle UCN staff who manage fleet vehicles disinfect vehicles after each use.
	Use of personal vehicles	Individuals are encouraged to follow physical distancing guidelines at all times. UCN guidelines must be followed where personal vehicle is being used for approved travel that is reimbursed.
	Northern Travel Restrictions	Only required travel allowed to the north. Exceptions for students, faculty, and staff of educational institutions, including UCN.
