OLD AND NEW BUSINESS

St. Casimir Mass and Coffee Hour – Linas Balsys thanked all members for attending today's mass celebrating the Feast of St. Casimir and for donating such a wonderful variety of pastries, cakes and sandwiches to the St. Joe's coffee hour. Marlene Shea motioned that we donate \$50 to the priest that celebrated the Mass (Father Amobi). After discussion, Bill Stokes suggested that given the current situation (e.g. no "permanent" home for our Council limiting our ability to hold fundraisers), we defer any payment until our year ends in June. Marlene Shea subsequently amended her motion proposing that we consider making our donation to the Church at year end in June. Judy Vecchitto seconded the motion which was approved unanimously.

<u>Mayor for the Day</u> – Linas Balsys encouraged all to attend and noted that he had reviewed Ed Paige's remarks and was truly moved by them. The ceremony at City Hall is scheduled for Friday, March 13, 2020 at 10 am.

<u>Club House</u> – Linas Balsys (on behalf of the Lithuanian Club) reported that the sale of the building and surrounding property to the Lithuanian Club is moving forward. The St. Joseph's Parish Finance Council approved the Lithuanian Club's offer for the building; the offer was subsequently forwarded to the Arch Diocese for their consideration. When a closing date is established, our Council will need to work with the Lithuanian Club to coordinate what needs to be removed, discarded, stored, etc.

As reported in the Winter 2020 Newsletter, as soon as March passes, it will be safe to turn the utilities off so the Treasurer has been asked to proceed with this action.

Marlene Shea is going to check with Fr. Aniello to see if we can use Our Lady of Mount Carmel hall for future events and will let us know what's possible at the next meeting.

<u>History of Lithuania</u> - Linas Balsys offered members the opportunity to purchase a book entitled: *History of Lithuania: From Medieval Kingdom to Modern Democracy* by Bronius Makauskas and Vytautas J.
