KNIGHTS OF LITHUANIA MANUAL

A. HISTORY OF THE KNIGHTS OF LITHUANIA RITUAL

The membership at the 25th National Convention, which met in Dayton, Ohio, on August 9, 1937, adopted a resolution which set up a committee for the formulation of the Ritual Rules and Ceremonial. The 26th National Convention, held in Chicago, Illinois, on August 10, 1938, adopted the Ritual. Rev. J. Urbonavicius was elected its first Chairperson, Jack Juozaitis - Treasurer, and Charles Stulgaitis - Secretary

B. PURPOSE OF RITUAL

- To reward members for devoted service to the Knights of Lithuania.
- 2. To add beauty, solemnity, and ceremonial to the organizational life of the Knights of Lithuania.
- 3. To encourage other members to strive for the achievement of the Knights of Lithuania.
- 4. To retain members who may lose interest in the Knights of Lithuania at certain intervals when other activities draw their attention

C. ORGANIZATION

1. SUPREME RITUAL COMMITTEE

The Supreme Ritual Committee consists of five members elected at the National Convention for the period of three years. The committee picks a Chairperson. The elections are staggered and the candidates must have their Fourth Degree.

The Chairperson calls meetings, prepares reports, write articles in the Vytis, schedules activities of the Committee and arranges the ceremonies for the Fourth Degree presentations. The chairperson signs all Third and Fourth Degree Certificates, Fourth Degree applications, issues Membership Cards for all degrees and prepares the Annual Report to the National Convention. The Chairperson reviews all requests for changes in Ritual Rules and Ceremonial as recommended by the National Convention.

The Supreme Ritual Committee is the custodian of the Supreme Council Seal and ceremony for the installation in the Fourth Degree.

2. DISTRICT RITUAL COMMITTEE

The District Ritual Committee consists of three Third Degree members, when possible, with one acting as Chairperson. If there is no Third Degree member in the District, the Supreme Ritual Committee will handle the duties until a member qualifies. This committee maintains files on all members in the District and their degree status. Councils send copies of all First and Second Degrees to the District Ritual Committee for their files. Third Degree applications are sent to the District Ritual Committee in triplicate per instructions in "Requirements for Degrees".

The District Ritual Committee makes arrangements for presentation of the Third Degree Medal, Certificate and Membership Card. The Medal is to be blessed and presented to the recipient at a District convention.

If a member cannot travel to a District convention, with approval of the District President, the Medal is to presented at a function sponsored by the local council, such as St. Casimir's Day.

The District Ritual Committee is to work with the Council Ritual Committee whenever it is needed.

3. COUNCIL RITUAL COMMITTEE

The Council Ritual Committee consists of Second Degree members, when possible, with one acting as chairperson. The Council Financial Secretary and Vice President are to be a part of the committee. This committee is to maintain records of points awarded the members for the various works they do.

As per "Requirements for Degrees", all First, Second and Fourth Degree applications are to be mailed to the Supreme Ritual Committee. Copies must be sent to the District Ritual Committee for their files.

Council Ritual Committee is responsible for installing candidates in the First and Second Degrees. After installation, when the Supreme Ritual Committee receives the application, a Membership Card will be issued.

REQUIREMENTS FOR DEGREES

FIRST DEGREE A member may be enrolled in the First Degree after one year membership in the organization and having accumulated three (3) points

One copy of the candidate's application must be submitted to the Supreme Ritual Committee soon after installation and a Membership Card will be issued. A copy must be sent to the District Ritual.

SECOND DEGREE A member is eligible after two (2) years membership as a First Degree Knight. Each applicant must have accumulated ten (10) points as outlined in the point system.

One copy of the candidate's application must be submitted to the Supreme Ritual Committee and a Membership Card will be issued. A copy must be sent to the District Ritual.

THIRD DEGREE A member is eligible after three (3) years as a Second Degree Knight. The applicant must have accumulated forty (40) points as outlined in the point system.

A fee of \$6.00 must accompany three (3) copies of each application to be sent to the District Ritual Committee. After District approval, a copy will be sent to the Supreme Ritual committee and a Certificate, Medal and Membership Card will be issued.

The District Ritual Committee will make arrangements for presentation at a District function. In cases where there is no District Ritual Committee, the Supreme Ritual Committee should be contacted.
