Council President Linas Balsys called the meeting to order at 10:35 am; members recited the Our Father and Pledge of Allegiance, and we offered prayers for members and family.

# Financial Secretary's Report

Linas Venclauskas reminded all that 2023 dues are being collected and must be paid by April 1<sup>st</sup>. He reported that about 2/3 of the current membership have paid their 2023 dues. Four new members were sworn into the Council: Kristina Johnson, Sara Johnson, Joseph Grincunas, and Matthew Conte-Lerner.

We also agreed to reinstate the 50/50 raffle beginning at the next meeting. Fran Stiklus will run the raffle at each meeting.

## **Membership Magic Contest**

Two new members paid their dues at the last meeting, so an executive decision was made to award prizes for both referrals. As a result, Violeta Stasonis and Christian Allyn qualify as being the first members to refer new members and are both eligible for \$15 Visa gift cards at the end of the contest. ## Membership Revitalization Committee (MRC) Report

<u>Traditional Advertising Tools - Flyers</u> – Joe Karmuza and Kristina Johnson worked together to print flyers that were inserted in the St. Joe's and OLMC bulletin. The OLMC flyers resulted in us welcoming two guests to today's meeting – Mary Jane Mazzarelli and Lauren Mancini. Joe and Kristina plan to print more flyers and insert not only in the St. Joe's and OLMC bulletins, but the St. Patrick's Church bulletins as well. To date, Joe has paid for the ink and paper needed to print the flyers, but he was encouraged to submit his receipts for payment by the Council. We will then submit a reimbursement request for 50% of the cost to the national Treasurer. President Balsys offered the use of his printer as it prints very quickly.

Marlene Warren reported that the website is almost ready to be sent to the Supreme Council in advance of the 4/22 meeting. The MRC will be demonstrating the refreshed website at that meeting and hopes to receive approval to go live on 5/1.
