## SILENT EMERGENCY RESPONSE

DURING SEPTEMBER OF 2022, HURRICANE IAN CAUSED WIDESPREAD DAMAGE ACROSS WESTERN CUBA AND THE SOUTHEAST OF THE US, ESPECIALLY IN THE STATES OF SOUTH CAROLINA AND FLORIDA. DURING THESE CHALLENGING TIMES, WITH THE HELP OF HIS SILENT 55 NAMED "ISABELLA" CHARLES DEYO STEPPED IN TO SUPPORT THOSE IN NEED.



Classified as a category 4 hurricane, Ian represented one of the most severe hurricane strikes the state of Florida had experienced since the 1935 Labor Day hurricane. Most of damage caused by the tropical storm was due to flooding. As a result, many were left without power or were even forced to seek refuge on their roofs.





Charles has been one of the earliest believers in our solar powered vision. Once the natural disaster had struck and the repercussions had become clear, he decided to create an instant emergency response by making use of Isabella. His plan started close to his home in Key West, Florida. The SILENT 55 was loaded with 6 tons of essential supplies, including food and drinking water. By travelling over 100 nm north, they reached Fort Myers, where the hurricane had made landfall and caused the most damage.



During the trip itself Charles enjoyed some beautiful views of the Gulf of Mexico. A beautiful sunset and sunrise accompanied him and Isabella on their mission.



Upon their arrival in Fort Myers, they received a warm welcome. Over 30 volunteers from several organizations such as the YMCA, United Way and the Harbor Base had gathered at the port to offer their assistance. Together, they unloaded the yacht and in continuation distributed the supplies to the victims of the hurricane.

For our entire team, it was truly heartwarming to hear that a SILENT yacht was used to aid a greater good as a tool for people to selflessly help those in need. Thank you, Charles!

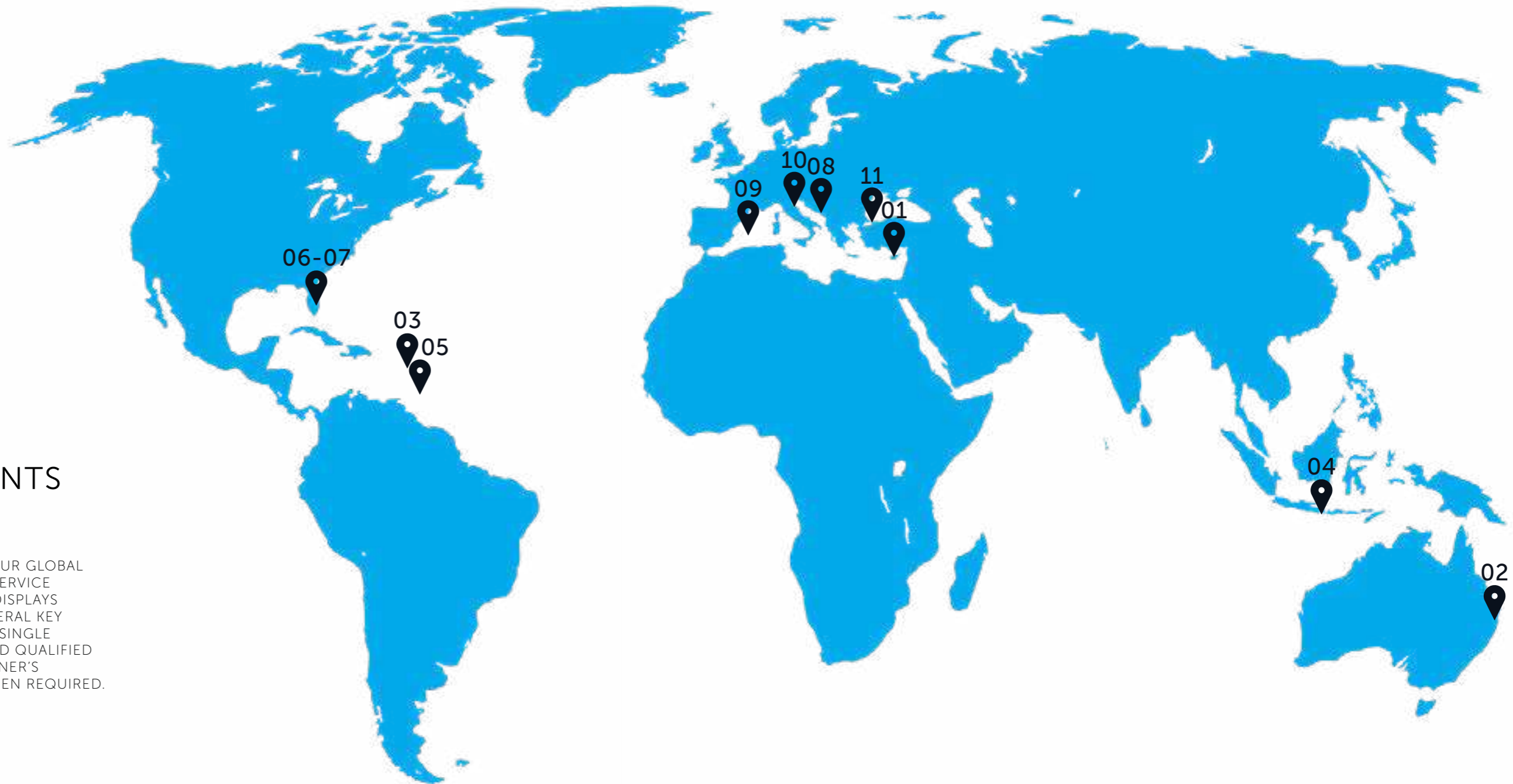

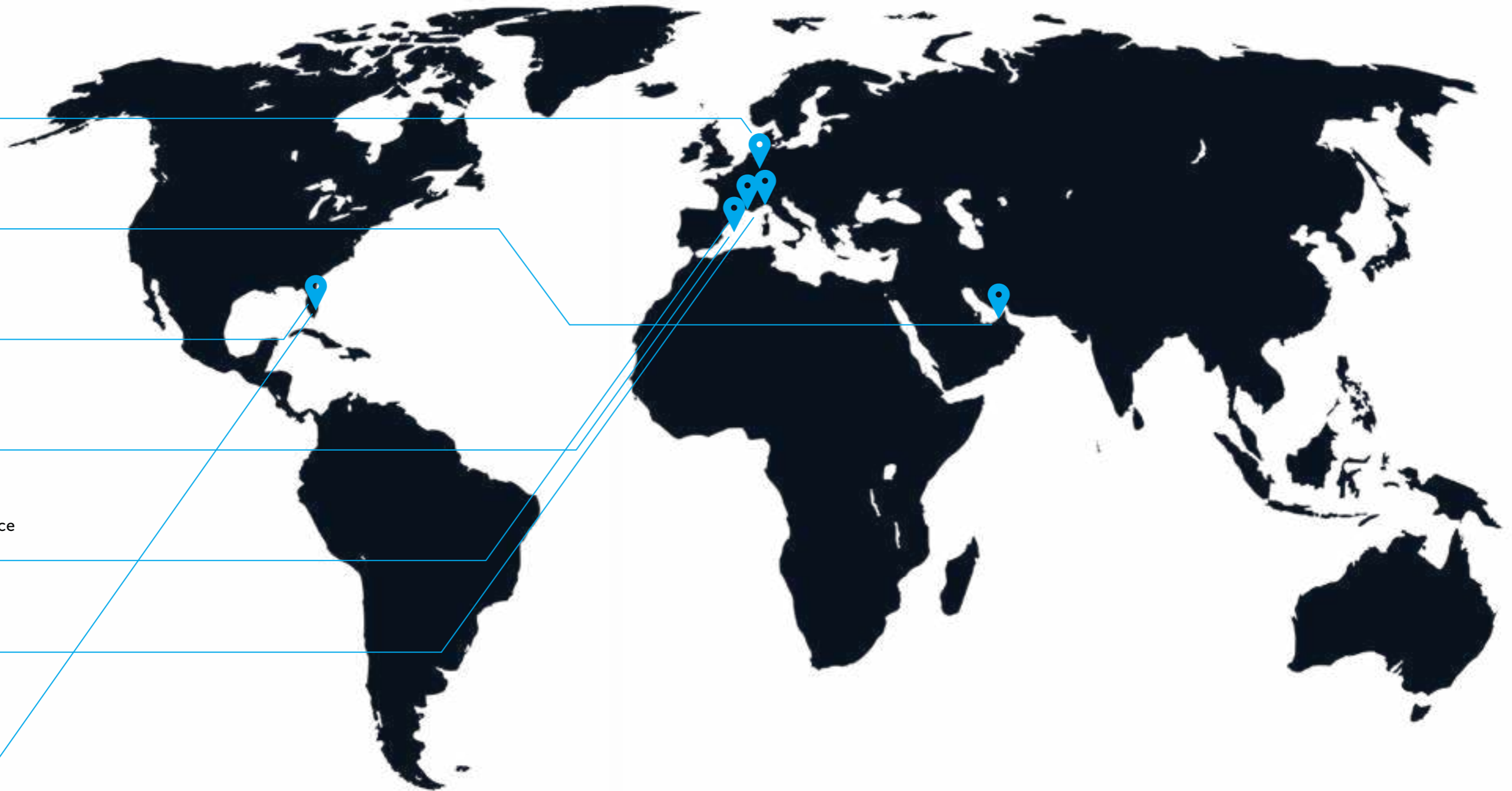
