Partnerships include **"Domestic Violence Awareness"** as our National Foundation. We participate on all levels of the organization to contribute to help out shelters and agencies in our chapter communities.



In 2020 the Women of Today organization celebrated 35 years as an organization in 12 states with various chapters in each.

Over these many years more than \$7,000,000 has been contributed to other foundations through the Women of Today organization.
