Goals

Transition & Discovery

Assumed Office: March 1, 2025

- Immediate outreach to outgoing Treasurer - despite requests, we have not met, nor spoken on phone. All communication limited to texts only.
- In Treasurer's Office, found files with limited documents, mostly from 2019-2021. Vice Treasurer and myself, together, have reviewed every document we retrieved from the office.
- Very few records for 2022-2024, no donor list, no ledger to reconcile against bank statements and public filings, checkbook showed no running balance, no records of Treasurer's Reports, no detailed invoice tracking
- Not informed that organization has TWO EINs. Discovered this after noticing EIN on bank account did not match EIN on lease contract. No documentation exists to explain why we have two EINs or when/why this change was made.

 **With no systems or complete records, we are rebuilding financial transparency from the ground up.**

Restoration & Systems Established

Building Our Financial Infrastructure

- Transferred control of Rockpoint bank account
- Moved from Autobooks to Anedot - full compliance & donor information required by Tennessee Registry of Election Finance.
- Opened QuickBooks Online - Every available bank statements and public filings uploaded to QuickBooks to reconstruct donor and expense records
- I can say bank statements and filings are now fully reconciled to the penny.
- Set baseline: \$23,608.85 as of Jan 15, 2025 - relevant date for my first TREF filing due July 15, 2025

 **Now running a transparent, traceable, and compliant system.**

Current Snapshot

As of April 14, 2025 (report submitted to CEC)

- Cash on hand: \$21,622.50
- Donations since March 1: \$6,917.43
- Expenses: Rent, Insurance, Utilities, Zoom, Google, GoDaddy, QuickBooks, Autobooks fees, Team Choices donation
- Old costs: No rent, insurance, or utilities costs. No employee.
- New costs are for financial systems and team management.
- 1 recurring donor asked to cancel
- 14 new monthly donors – Every officer is a monthly donor!

 **We are building consistency, trust, and momentum – reducing overhead, in order to maximize every dollar for direct impact towards growing our team, expanding our influence, and winning elections.**

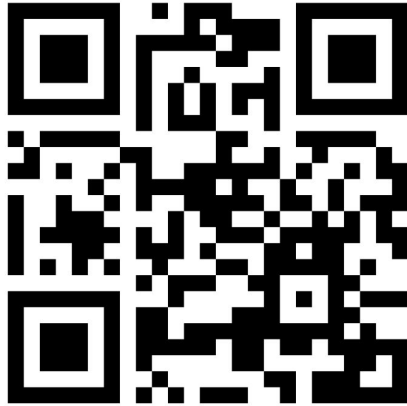
