**"Sense of Community"** - *Discover a new activity, a club or simply create an occasion to come out and have a brew with your neighbour as the runners go past!*

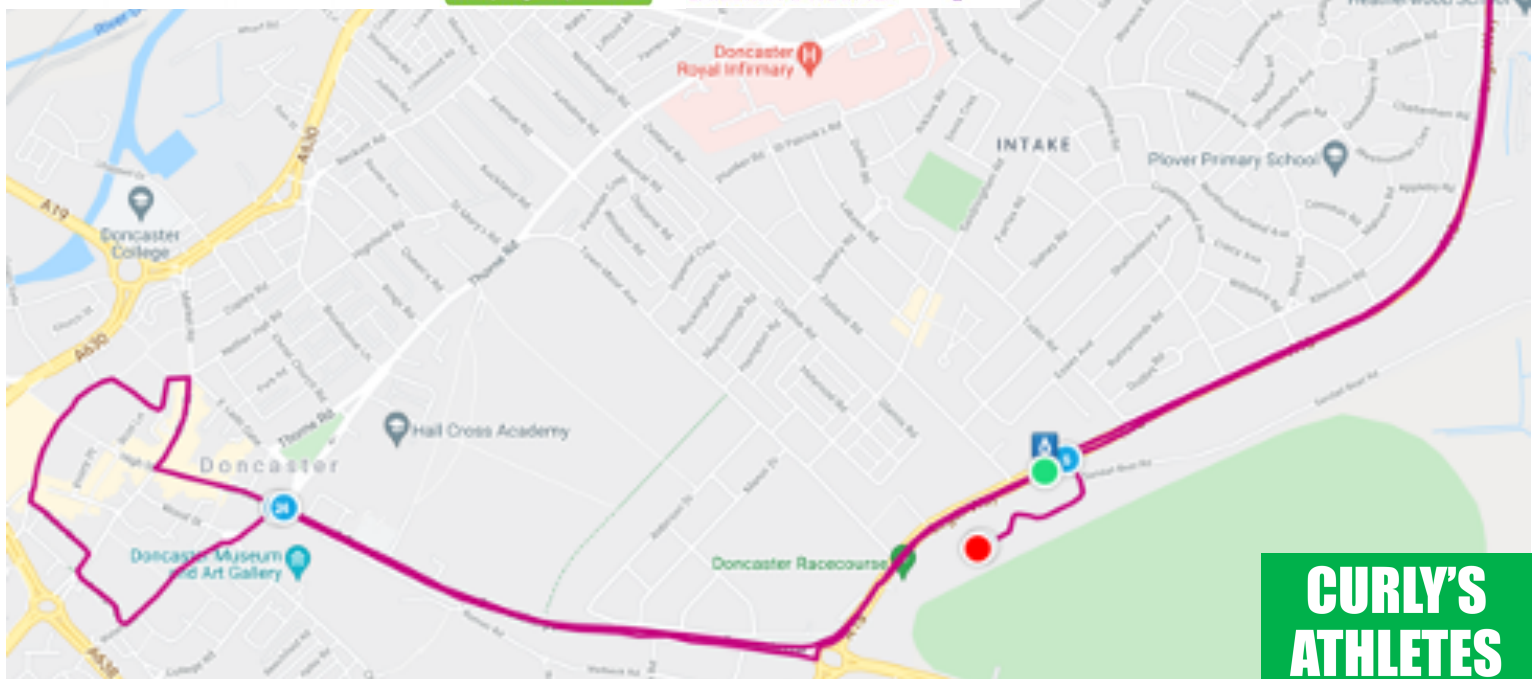
**...You can also Get Involved** – *Volunteer, fundraise or showcase your community, school, club or business on the route.*

**All times are approximate and subject to change**

*Runners will be on the course from 10:00 – 12:00 so please come out and support.*

*Traffic management will be installed from 07:00 on-going. We expect this to be fully cleared for 12:00, roads are also cleared as the runners pass through, the town centre & Bennetthorpe area will be cleared at 11:00. A18 – Leger Way	09:30-12:00 From Armthorpe roundabout to Racecourse roundabout
Bennetthorpe & South Parade	07:00-11:00 Outbound - From Town to Racecourse roundabout 09:30-10:30 Inbound - From Danum road to Waterdale *From Danum road to Waterdale the road will be closed for a shorter period as the runners pass, from 09:30-10:30. Outside of this time it allows for inbound traffic to access/exit on the west side of Bennetthorpe and through to Waterdale exiting via Chequer Road
Waterdale	07:00-11:00 - Closed eastbound from roundabout with Chequer Rd - Closed both directions from college road to roundabout with Chequer Rd
Wood Street	07:00-11:00 - Closed from Cleveland street to Waterdale
College Way	07:00-11:00 - Closed, but access available to car park from waterdale
Cleveland St	07:00-11:00 - Closed from College Rd to Duke Street roundabout
Duke Street	07:00-11:00 - Closed from Cleveland st to St Sepulchre Gate
West Laith Gate	07:00-11:00 - Closed from Duke St to St Sepulchre Gate
Cleveland St	07:00-11:00 - Closed from Hallgate to College rd
St Sepulchre Gate	07:00-11:00 - Closed from Duke St to High St Pedestrian access still available
