VILLAGE OF MEAD BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING MINUTES

Posting at the Bank of Mead, US Post Office, Village Office & all members of the Board were provided notice in advance. A Regular Meeting and Public Hearing of the Chairman & Board of Trustees of the Village of Mead, NE was held 3/10/26 at 6pm at the Village Office. Answering roll call were Chairman Thorson; Trustees Felty, Simon, Lee & Wielage. Also present was Clerk Cooper. Guests were Andy Jackson & PJ Quinn. The posting of the Open Meetings Law was noted. Approved were the agenda, minutes of the February 10 Reg Mtg & Pub Hearing, Treasurer's Report, and Claims.

PJ Quinn- presented plans from school engineer/architect for new elementary school storm shelter. Disc held RE: Research Memo from Village Attorney for Ord to reduce storm shelter required min. occupancy- Planning Commission to scheduled second Pub Hearing.

The following motions were made, seconded, and approved 5-0: Introduce, suspend statutory rules, and adopt Ord No. 854 (Roadrunner) and Ord No. 855 (S2)- non-exclusive franchise to collect & dispose of garbage; adopt Res 26-02- approving interlocal coop agreement for creation of a Mutual Finance Organization pursuant to Legislative Bill 1120(1998); approve \$300 donation to Mead Easter Egg Hunt; approve SDL for Mead PTO Trivia Night on 4/19 at the Fire Hall; approve SDL for Kristina Salda baby shower on 4/11 at the Fire Hall. Disc held: notice from CAT for exp ESC for generators.

Supt- written report on completed tasks was presented and disc held RE: proposal from CAT for VisionLink, speed radar signs, flushing hydrants, ballfield fence, and tin roof install at sewer plant. Library- 3/3 Library Board minutes were accepted. Planning Commission- Permits approved 26-01 AWS-drill 2 new wells at Insulfoam and 26-02 Brian Degner-construct. Clerk Report- disc held RE: status of FEMA process & new website, and digitizing docs proposal from Bishop Business. Police/Nuisance- Notice & Agreement for 105 E 5th & Notice for 522 S. Vine.
