Applicants for the Primary 3-6 program must be at least 3 years old by September 1st and toilet trained. Applicants for the Toddler program must be 2 years old by September 1st or date of entrance. Exceptions to this requirement will be made only if all the following conditions are met: (1) all agequalified applicants have been enrolled, (2) the child is ready for the particular Montessori program, and (3) admission is in accordance with current state and federal child-care age requirements.

Applications are processed on a first-come, first-serve basis. However, priority is given to siblings of alumni and current students who apply by February 1st. Also, consideration is given to classroom balance according to age, sex, and previous Montessori experience, if any.

Parents will be contacted and visits conducted in March and April for Primary and Toddler classes for admission to the fall programs. An Advanced Tuition Deposit (approximately 10% of the annual tuition) will be required upon acceptance of your child into the appropriate program. This deposit is deducted from the annual tuition, and is not the first month's tuition payment.

A trial period of six weeks in the classroom follows admission. During this trial period, either the school or the parents may decide that the situation is not beneficial to the student, whether new or previously enrolled, and the student may be withdrawn or dismissed from the school with no penalty to the parents or the School.
