
O COME, O COME, EMMANUEL

Pastoral Note: The verses of this ancient chant reflect the O Antiphons which are sung during Advent vespers the 7 days preceding the Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord. Each verse portrays a specific attribute of Emmanuel, the Word made flesh.
