MTK Foundation Rules:

- **Sign up deadline is July 16, 2021.**
- Load in time starts at 2pm – Chicken distribution will be at 3:00 when load in gates close.
- Each cook team will be allotted 4 entry wrist bands.
- Wings are required to be ready for serving by 5:00pm when gates open to the public.
- The wing contest will be held from 7-8pm – 6 wings need to be provided for the judges to enter the contest for the GRAND PRIZE.
- All cook teams must fill out a temporary food establishment application and submit to the MTK foundation along with this form by July 16. (see attachment)
- Alcohol permitted for cook team personal use ONLY, not for distribution to guests. Anyone caught providing alcohol to the public will be asked to leave.

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- Cleanup- All cook teams are required to thoroughly cleanup their own stations.  
All trash needs to be distributed in provided dumpster outside the gate.
  - Cook teams need to provide their own trash can to dispose of all cooking and personal trash.
  - Please do not throw trash on the ground and leave behind.

**MTK foundation will provide:**

- All chicken wings
- Paper boats for serving
- Wrist bands will be provided
- Beer will be served for free from 5pm- 9:30pm (last call)

**Cook teams must provide:**

- All seasonings for wings
- All requirements of the Temporary Event Checklist provided from the City of Amarillo (see attachment)
- Personal Trashcan
- Napkins/paper towels
- \*Optional- your best side dish to go with your best wings (please provide correct utensils if needed)
- \*Personal coolers of alcohol – **Please** do NOT distribute to guests of the event

- \* **Licensed Caterers:** Licensed caterers must obtain a permit but are exempt from fees.
- \* **Advanced Preparation:** If you are cooking or preparing food items prior to your event, an additional permit will be required for the proposed location. An inspection is required during the cooking or food preparation process. If advanced preparation is being conducted in a licensed food establishment, then the additional permit fee may be waived.
- \* **Pre-Packaged Non-TCS Vendors:** If you are only serving pre-packaged Non-TCS food items (Ex: chips, cokes, candy bars in the original packaging) you will be exempt from permitting.
