Clay's finest performance of 1971 was his sparkling one-hitter vs. Giants, Sept. 18th. The only hit Clay allowed was a Homer by Willie McCovey as Padres won, 2-1. Had no-hitter going vs. Mets, 7-21-70, but was trailing 1-0 & was removed for pinch-hitter in last of 8th.

**CLAYTON LAWS KIRBY**

The Expos are ecstatic over the acquisition of this little-used righty from the Reds over the winter. Whereas Clay will likely move into Mgr. Kuehl's starting rotation, the player he was traded for, Bob Bailey, didn't fit into the Expo plans. Clay compiled a 10-6 record and a 4.70 ERA in 26 appearances in '75, his 2nd year in Cincinnati following his '73 acquisition from San Diego. He was signed by St. Louis in '66 and had gotten to their AAA farm club, Tulsa, before being drafted by San Diego. He had hard times in S.D. but did strikeout 231 in '71. Owns a 74-96 record, 1010 K's, and a 3.73 ERA in 239 big league games.
