WOODY TAYLOR

WARREN W. "WOODY" TAYLOR was involved in the Arlington sports scene for over forty years. He was a championship youth baseball and football coach. As manager of Vet Vans and Arlington Motors in the 1950's and 1960's, his teams won several Little Major league titles and he coached the Arlington Optimist All-Stars to a state title in 1959. He was named Arlington Coach of the Year in 1964. Woody had a keen affinity for the game of football. He coached the Arlington Optimist 115 lb. youth football team and spent many years as a gridiron official and member of the Board of the Northern Virginia Football Officials Association. In 1992, Woody became only the second person to be inducted into the Football Officials Hall of Fame. Woody was past president of the Better Sports Club (1965), and received the Billy Castleberry Award in 1969 for being the Club's Outstanding Member.
