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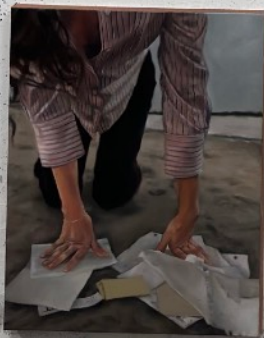


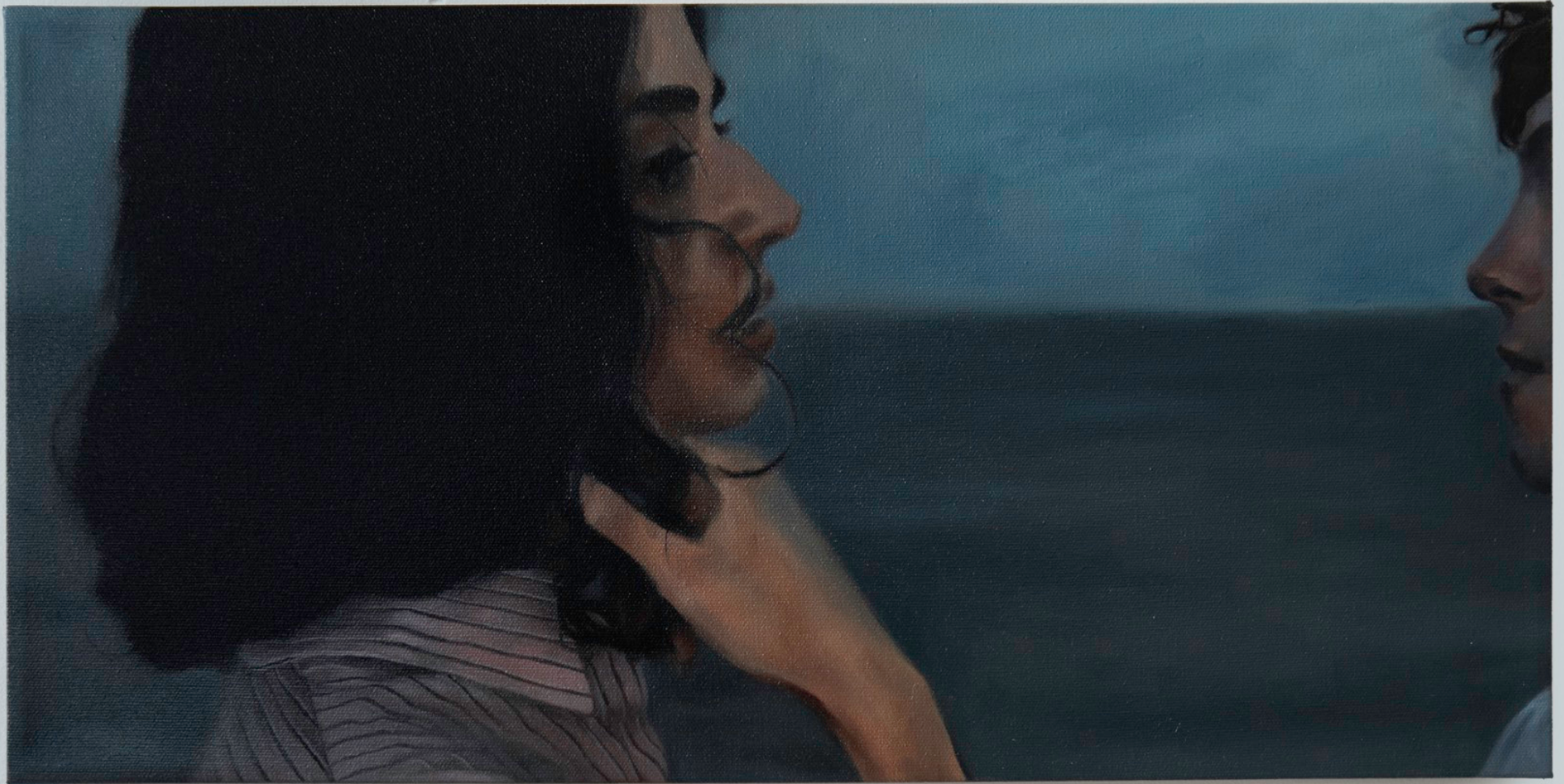
The artist Jackie Klein will present new works created this summer especially for ART-O-RAMA.

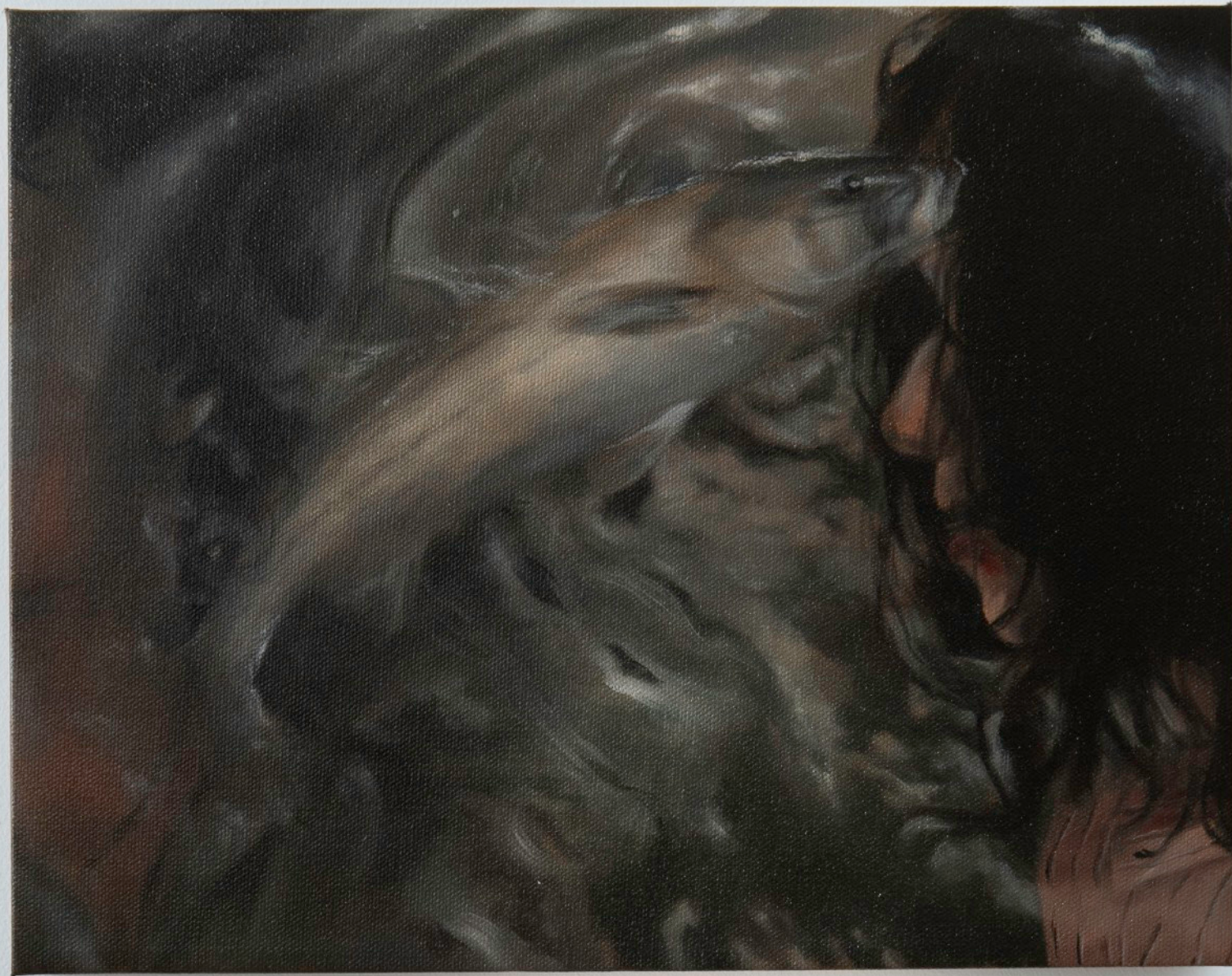

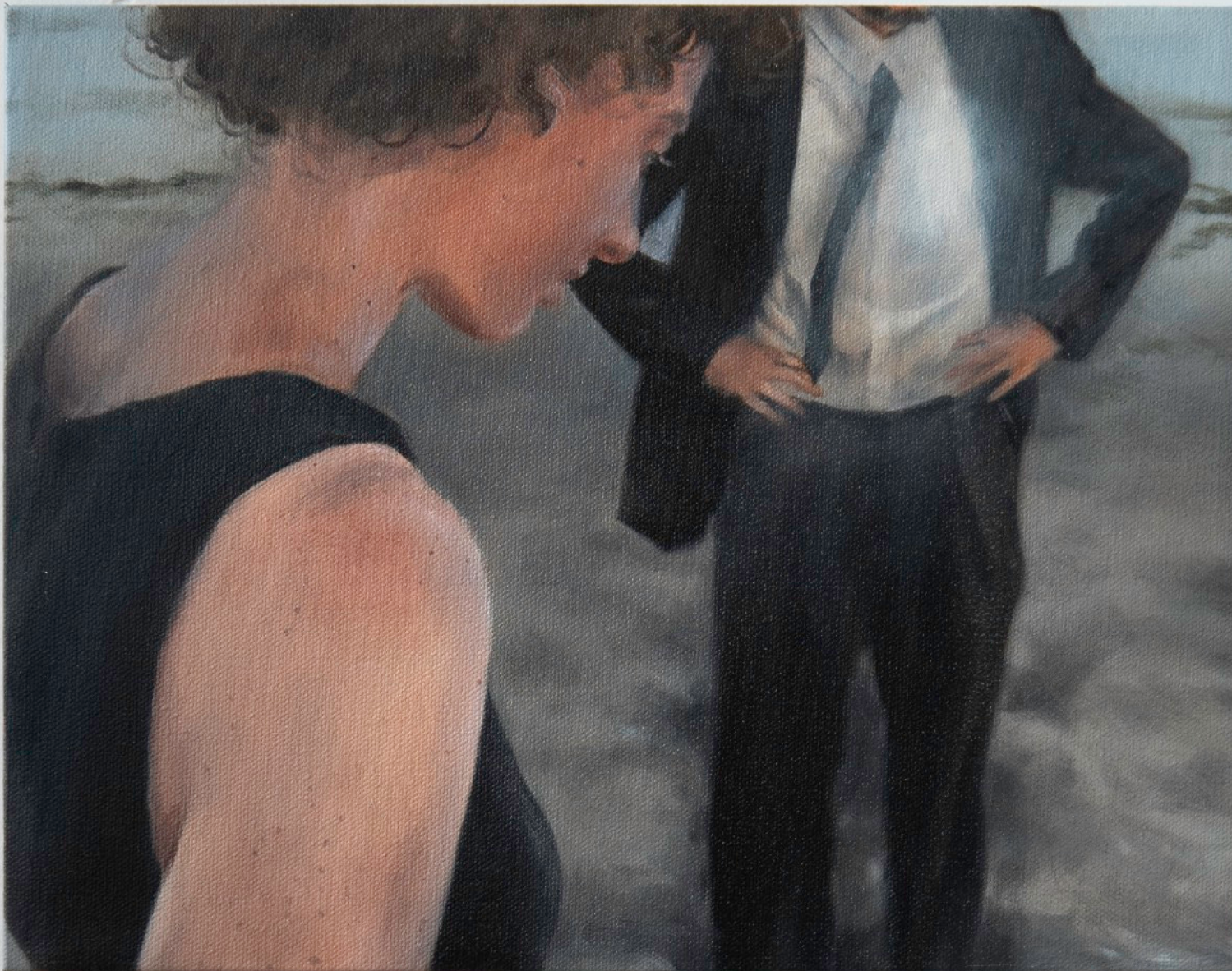

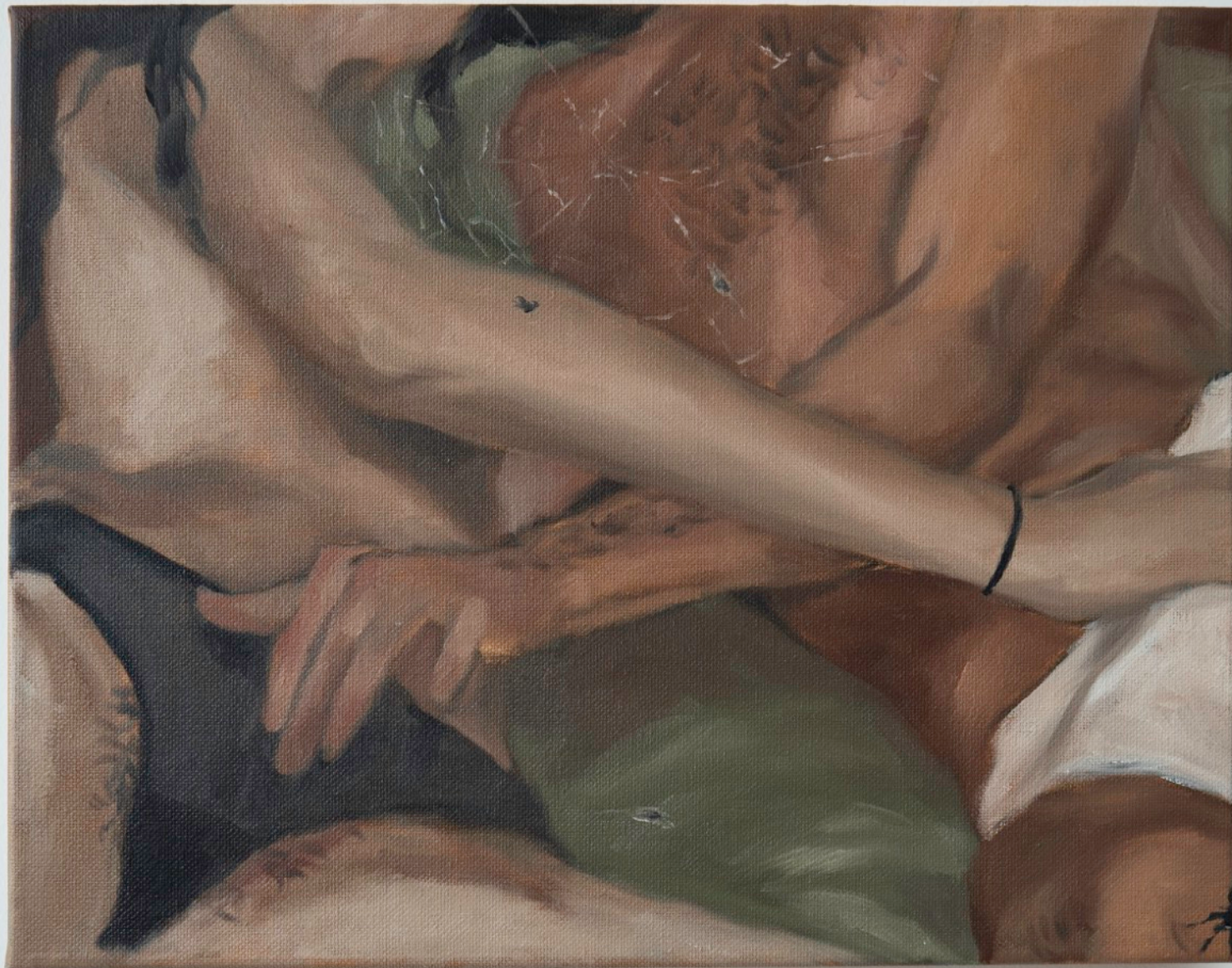

Artist Statement

Jackie Klein makes melancholic figurative oil paintings that marry the visual languages of film and classical portraiture. Though most compositional elements in Klein's paintings are drawn from everyday life, it is their odd placement and re-contextualization that creates a mysterious, otherworldly feel. Klein's early, atelier style training is evident in their interest in light and figuration, while romantic details such as backlit wisps of hair or dark silhouettes create a cinematic quality. A "fish out of water" style dissonance permeates the compositions– a dark undercurrent of impending something, the existentialism and intrigue of an uncertain future. Jackie juxtaposes anxious, suited figures with tenderly rendered seascapes, sharp black edges with soft waves and glowing reflections, grappling with a constant thematic and aesthetic consideration of what to reveal and what to conceal–what to highlight and what to obfuscate.
