How we started?

The #SpitalePubliceDinBaniPrivati project was born in the Fundeni Clinical Institute, from the pain in a 7 years old little girl's eyes, the girl who lost the salon sparkles, on the bed of a hospital without a bathroom, anointed and with the smell of fear at every step.

This image imprinted in Codin Maticiuc's mind, and her story mobilized us all to start doing, for those who today are fighting for their life laying on a hospital bed and who still have hope for a cure.



Short history:

#SPITALE PUBLICE BAN PRIVATI

In the last 4 years, the SpitalePubliceDinBaniPrivati project has been supporting patients who deal with the Public Health System, and among our most important achievements are:

We changed the tax law through which NGOs that invest in the Public Health System can recover their VAT, a fact that did not happen until now. Thus we helped all the NGOs in the country to invest even more in the quality of life of patients.

We have improved the admission conditions for more than 300,000 patients, so that they receive medical care in the best possible conditions.

Total investment in projects:

Over 3.5 million Euros. We were present with our projects in 18 cities (Bucharest, Cluj-Napoca, Oradea, Constanța, Reșița, Timișoara, Bacău, Piatra Neamț, Călărași, Tecuci, etc.) We helped 25 hospitals through renovation and equipping projects.



On going projects:

#SPITALE PUBLICE BAN PRIVATI

The Surgical Department of the Fundeni Clinical Institute, one of the largest transplant centers in Romania.

Peeling walls, old doors with scratched and yellowed paint, rusty radiators, wardrobes with a string for a handle, wooden chairs and beds. Beds that were once brown, but today are too damaged to distinguish their true color.

This is what the 37 patients admitted to the Surgical Department of the Fundeni Clinical Institute see every day, as if the pain of fighting the disease were not enough. A ward with a team of 11 surgeons walking a hallway with patched door frames and chipped tiles, trying to heal.

The renovation, furnishing and equipping of the entire department involves an investment of approximately 1 million Euros, and the completion of the project is estimated at the end of 2024.


The Maternity Department of Neonatology of the Dominic Stanca Clinic in Cluj-Napoca, the largest specialized clinic in the county.

The Dominic Stanca Obstetrics and Gynecology Clinic annually brings into the world approximately 2000 newborns whose medical care from the first days of life is essential to be at the highest standards.

The medical staff provides the best quality care, trying to compensate for the conditions in which they have to do it. In March 2024, the renovation of the Maternity will be completed, and by the end of September, the renovation of the Neonatology Department will also be completed.

The total investment for this ongoing project amounts to approximately 500,000 Euros.

Short presentation:

Pediatric Psychiatry Clinic of the Clinical Hospital "Prof. Dr. Alexandru Obregia" is a reference clinic in Romania for the treatment of mental health disorders in children and adolescents. It is the most representative institution in the field, an aspect revealed by the significant addressability (5021 children evaluated in 2022).


The Clinic offers pediatric psychiatry services for children and adolescents from Bucharest, Ilfov and neighboring counties in South-East Romania, but also from national level.

The main 3 pathologies in the field of pediatric mental illness are severe depression with suicidal tendencies and self-harm, conduct disorder and use of illegal substances. Currently, due to the lack of clinic conditions, children aged up to 4-5 years with behavioral disorders, autism, ADHD cannot have continuous hospitalization for treatment.

The number of admissions (continuous and day) has increased steadily over the last 5 years, except during the pandemic period when admissions were subject to restrictions and sanitary norms regarding distance.

- →3839 patients in 2018
- →4436 patients in 2019 (+ 15% vs. the previous year)
- →2804 patients in 2020 (-47% vs. the previous year, pandemic year)
- →523 patients in 2021 (-82% vs. the previous year, pandemic year)
- →5021 patients in 2022 (+13% vs 2019)
- \rightarrow 2751 in the first 6 months of 2023 (+9% vs the first 6 months of 2022)

The number of admissions is unusually high for any pediatric psychiatry clinic at the level European Community.


Statistics:


The clinical picture of mental health disorders has undergone an important change in recent years.

We can see a significant increase in emergency hospitalization cases of suicide attempts, depressive disorders with autolytic behaviors, emotional and behavioral disorders with auto- and hetero-aggressive behaviors, disorders due to the consumption of psychotropic substances, spectrum disorders high-functioning autistic, Asperger's disorder with depressive, autolytic or heteroaggressive decompensation, eating disorders - anorexia and bulimia nervosa, disharmonious personality structures, etc. continuous and daily for all pathologies.

A significant increase in 2022 as well as in the first 6 months of 2023 in the number of continuous and day hospitalizations for all pathologies stands out.







#SPITALE PUBLICE BAIN PRIVATI

Needs:

The current Pediatric Psychiatry Clinic of the Clinical Hospital "Prof. Dr. Al. Obregia" has a number of 62 beds, 57 beds for acute pathology and 5 beds for chronic pathology, distributed in 2 pavilions.

Achieving the objective of increasing the surface necessary for the proper treatment of patients could be achieved through the construction of a new building, intended exclusively for pediatric psychiatry specialization.

Currently, the clinic also treats young users of illegal substances who present with symptoms of drug abuse and withdrawal.


In these cases, the therapeutic intervention plan is a complex, multidisciplinary one, involving several stages depending on the particularity of each case.

At this moment, patients with substance use disorders are admitted to the beds assigned to all mental health pathologies specific to children and adolescents.

The project is in Stage 1 – realization of the design theme.

Next:

- → Stage 2 realization of the architectural project;
- → Stage 3 construction approval/authorization;
- → Stage 4 construction company contracting/budgeting;
- → Stage 5 project execution.

A new Pediatric Psychiatry Clinic - 2026

The new Pediatric Psychiatry Clinic, by setting up spaces dedicated to patients with disorders related to the consumption of psychoactive substances, will represent a major change with a strong impact in the community, as currently there is a major deficit in terms of adequate mental health services, supervision and management for children and adolescents using psychoactive substances.

Moreover, it is essential to set up dedicated spaces for the proper treatment of ailments, addressing a complete circuit from surveillance to healing.

The new building will be built in the courtyard of the Clinical Hospital of Psychiatry "Prof. Dr. Alexandru Obregia" and will be arranged as follows:

- → GROUND FLOOR: 12 medical offices, a reserve with a bed, wardrobe for patients with storage of personal effects
- → IST FLOOR: I psychological office, space for nurses which will be equipped with a patient supervision and call nurse and educational room.
- → FLOOR 2: 2 reserves with 1 bed, library area for adolescent patients and space for nurses which will be equipped with patient monitoring system and nurse call.
- → FLOOR 3: educational room for teenagers, space for medical staff, administration offices of the pavilion.
- → FLOOR 4: 2 large multifunctional rooms that can be partitioned with removable soundproof walls, along with 2 small meeting rooms, bathrooms and cloakrooms. T

The estimated investment for the construction of the building amounts to 5.5 million Euros, not including the necessary furniture and/or equipment
