The Constitutional and Historical Basis for the 30,000 Elector Threshold by President Jim Geiger

The requirement of at least thirty thousand (30,000) Republic Electors (Voters) as the threshold for transitioning from territorial status to full de jure statehood, enabling permanent elections for governors and other officers, is directly grounded in Article I, Section 2, Clause 3 of the 1789 Constitution: "The Number of Representatives shall not exceed one for every thirty Thousand, but each State shall have at Least one Representative..." This clause, penned by the Founders and ratified as part of the original Constitution, establishes a fundamental republican principle: representation in the House of Representatives is tied to population, with a maximum ratio of one Representative per 30,000 inhabitants, while guaranteeing each free state at least one Representative regardless of size. As James Madison explained in Federalist No. 56, this ratio was chosen to balance effective representation with manageable legislative size, ensuring the

People's voice is neither diluted nor overwhelmed. The 30,000 figure thus represents the minimum population the Founders deemed sufficient for meaningful state-level representation in the national government—a benchmark of republican maturity.

Historically, the Northwest Ordinance of 1787 (re-enacted as 1 Statute 50 in 1789) set a higher threshold of 60,000 free inhabitants for automatic admission to statehood (Article V), but explicitly allowed Congress to admit territories earlier “when there may be a less number of free inhabitants in the State than sixty thousand,” provided a republican constitution was formed. This flexibility recognized that statehood required sufficient population for viable self-governance but was not rigidly fixed. The Constitution's 30,000 inhabitant ratio for representation became the practical lower bound in early practice, as it ensured a state could sustain at least one Representative, affirming its sovereignty on equal footing.

In the Republic for the United States of America's re-inhabitation process, the 30,000 active Republic Electors (Voters) threshold adapts this constitutional standard to modern circumstances. It serves as a prudent, republican requirement for transitioning from provisional territorial governance to permanent *de jure* statehood, ensuring:

- **Sufficient Population for Representation:** A state with fewer than 30,000 active electors (voters) risks inadequate representation in a restored Congress, violating the Founders' intent for proportional yet guaranteed voice (Federalist No. 52).
- **Republican Maturity:** The threshold guarantees a critical mass of engaged Citizens capable of sustaining elections, legislatures, and courts, preventing premature statehood that could lead to instability—as warned against in early territorial experiences (Northwest Ordinance precedents).
- **Equal Footing and Sovereignty:** By aligning with the constitutional representation ratio, the threshold ensures new free States enter the Republic each with equal footing with each other, fulfilling Article IV, Section 4's guarantee of a republican form of government.
- **Practical Adaptation:** While the Northwest Ordinance used 60,000 inhabitants, the Constitution's 30,000 inhabitant ratio provides a lower, constitutionally grounded benchmark suitable for re-inhabitation in an era of corporate vacancy post-1871 (16 Statute 419). This reflects RuSA's faithful application of founding principles to restore the American People's sovereignty.

Therefore, the 30,000 electors (voters) threshold is not arbitrary but has a direct constitutional anchor, ensuring that when a territory achieves the threshold through diligent elector (voter) enrollment, it may hold lawful elections for permanent officers, transitioning to full *de jure* status. Provisional officers, serving voluntarily and in good behavior, bridge this gap, preparing the ground as territorial officers did under 1 Statute 50—advising, organizing, and building toward the day when the American People fully reclaim their republican inheritance.

Enhanced Findings and Conclusions

The Implementation of the Northwest Ordinance codified as 1 Statute 50, as adapted by RuSA, faithfully restores the Founders' vision of staged governance: provisional authority under presidential appointment (1 Statute 50) gives way to permanent, elected structures once the American People demonstrate sufficient engagement (30,000 active

Republic Electors (Voters)). This process rejects corporate centralization by empowering local assemblies first, then state-level electors, culminating in national restoration. It honors 1 Statute 50's promise of equal footing and republican forms while adapting the Constitution's representation ratio to ensure viable, sovereign free States. Provisional officers' voluntary service without emolument echoes the Founders' civic virtue, preparing for a Republic where power returns fully to the American People (Federalist No. 57). May this threshold inspire diligent work toward the day when all states stand de jure once more.

"So, having documented the key instances where it was necessary for the Interim Government to give Lawful notice to the *de facto* UNITED STATES corporation, and acknowledging that we continue to operate parallel to said corporation, we see no current requirement to give further notice. Let it be known that any agent (or officer of the Republic), unless authorized by the President in writing, has no Lawful authority from the Republic to serve notice on *de facto* officers on behalf of the Republic; and, if they do so, then they are acting in their own private capacity and DO NOT represent the Republic."

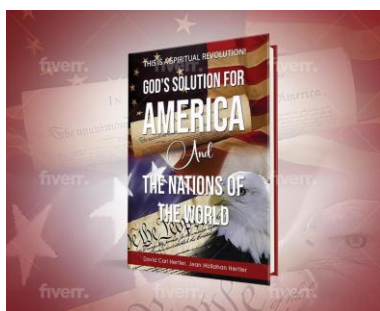
