

# 2024 SLAK RULES

## ROSTERS--

Salary Cap \$160.00

Draft-2 QB, 4 RB, 5 WR, 2 D 2 FLEX POSITION

Start-1 QB, 2RB, 3WR, 1D, + 1 extra WR or RB +1 FLEX - QB, RB, WR or DEF

Rookies do not count as part of your roster

## DRAFT ORDERS & TIE BREAKERS--

First 2 rounds of the draft are 1-10 then serpentine. The rules for playoffs and next years draft order, both regular and rookie. The four teams that do not make the playoffs will have the first four picks in both drafts. The rookie order will be inverse to the total points scored. The regular draft will be inverse to final record. Any ties will be broken by the same rules that we use for playoff positioning which are:

Total Points scored, Head-to-Head and Division Record.

The remaining six teams will continue to turn in starting lineups to determine 1st through 6th place until week 17. The same rules will then apply to the final six teams. In fairness this ensures that teams not qualifying for the playoffs cannot be put into a late draft spot and be double penalized for bad luck.

Ties during the season will remain ties.

If you go over \$160.00 after the draft you lose your first pick if still not under you lose your second.

## ROOKIES--

Rookie draft held the first part of June

Maximum of three rookies on your team at any time unless you trade for one. Which can only be done in season.

Rookies may be assigned a \$5.00 R contract in their second year

## Contract Players--

Two year contract players may not be traded.

You can only cut your 1 & 2 year contract player if he is out for the year or retired and you are responsible for 1/2 of his salary, rounded up, and this can only be done before the draft. The retired players name must be off NFL.COM to be eligible to be cut.

Contracts will be assigned at the July meeting.

2 year contract players must be resigned at market value.

1 year contracts will be bid on prior to the regular draft. Three bids per team. Owner must match highest bid, if he doesn't he goes to the highest bidder. If no one bids on your one year contract you must keep him at the price you signed him to. Lower team, previous year, wins tie bids if both teams out of bids.

### **Weekly starters-**

Thurs and Sat players must be turned in prior to kickoff.

Final rosters are due before the games start on Sunday.-

If you don't have a defense to play or play one on bye it's -10 points.

If you neglect submitting your roster two weeks in a row, find a new league next year.

### **Free agency and trades--**

After the draft your roster is flexible. Live with 1 QB if you choose.

Trades can be made weeks 3-14 Also at the Summer meeting.

1 future draft pick allowed in season trades

If two owners believe a trade is unfair it will go to the league for vote.

Free agent moves will be made before weeks 3, up to before week 13 and are due by Wednesday 9 p.m. of that week.

Trade deadline in season is Saturday at 10 p.m.

5 moves per year 1 per free agent week

Highest bidder receives free agent. Lower team wins ties.

### **Payoffs--**

Tie breakers are total points scored, head to head, and division record.

\$200.00 entry fee. 1/2 must be paid by the rookie draft, remainder at regular draft.

Head to head schedule as posted on website.

1st place \$700.00

2nd place \$475.00

3rd place-\$300.00

4th place \$200.00

5th place \$150.00

6th place \$100.00
