What Residential Parking Permits Are

Residential parking permits allow eligible residents to park on certain streets within designated residential parking districts.

Eligibility

- 1 Available only to the property owner or authorized agent who resides at the address within a residential permit district.
- 2 Property owners may authorize someone else to apply using an online authorization form.

Residential Districts

The City provides maps and descriptions of each residential permit district (e.g., Anholm, Alta Vista, College Highlands). Vehicles parked without valid permits in these districts may be cited.

Buying Residential Permits

- 1 Cost: \$20 per permit.
- 2 Maximum of two permits per eligible address per year.
- 3 Permits expire September 15 of each year.
- 4 Purchase methods: Mail, in person at Parking Services office, or via authorized property management company.
