

Pace of Play

The CALGA Pace of Play requirement strives to maintain a ‘prompt’ pace of play in all tournaments. Each player is responsible for maintaining her group’s position in relation to the group in front of them. Please try to adhere to the following suggestions:

- Play ready golf on the tee box, in the fairway and on the putting green.
- Think about your shot before you get to your ball and have your club and be ready to hit
- Pre-shot routine—keep to a minimum of 1-2 practice swings
- Share the cart responsibilities...
 - If possible, go to your ball while your cart partner is hitting. Be sure to take multiple clubs and/or distance finder so you do NOT have to go back to cart. Or drop your cart mate off and then pick them up or have them walk up to your ball after you hit.
- If you need to chip at the green, be sure to take all the clubs you might use.
- Park the cart behind the green so group behind you can hit
- On the green, mark your ball. When able, line up your putt while others are putting, without disturbing them. Leave your clubs on the side of the putting green closest to the next tee and leave the green promptly after holing out.
- Clean and put clubs away at the next tee box to clear the green for group behind you
- Fill out the score card and/or exchange scores on the next tee box.
